The Regional Road 5 (Hwy. 5) Corridor Strategy will focus on the sections in Oakville and Burlington. The Regional Road 25 (Hwy. 25) Corridor Strategy will focus on 2 sections, QEW to Burnhamthorpe in Oakville and between Britannia and Derry Roads in the Town of Milton.

It is essential that these Corridor Strategies be prepared with the direct participation and involvement of the general public, road users, abutting landowners and residents of nearby neighbourhoods. There are two public meetings scheduled for this study in June.
