### Hospital foundation needs your support

Dear Editor:

I was in attendance at a recent meeting held at the Optimist Centre on Friday, June 12 regarding the changes taking place at the Milton District Hospital in its amalgamation with Oakville Trafalgar Memorial Hospital.

In response to questions from the floor, it was pointed out by hospital administrator Allan Halls that funds raised by the Milton District Hospital Foundation will stay in Milton.

However, there are rumors in some circles in town that funds raised here will all go to Oakville and, as a result, some local people and groups will no longer want to donate funds to the hospital.

I would like to set the record straight for the misinformed.

The Milton District Hospital Foundation is not directly involved in the amalgamation of the two hospitals, but is a separate entity. The foundation is a federally chartered non-profit corporation founded in 1980 with the purpose of raising funds for the hospital, and it enjoys exceptional support from the community at large. It will continue to do this for as long as we have a hospital site in Milton.

That is not to say that we would not in the future join in with the Oakville Trafalgar Charitable Corp. in funding projects of mutual benefit to both of our sites, just as we did for the recent MRI project with Joseph Brant hospital in Burlington and Oakville hospital.

The funds raised over the years have gone toward the purchase of new equipment or updating aging equipment with
