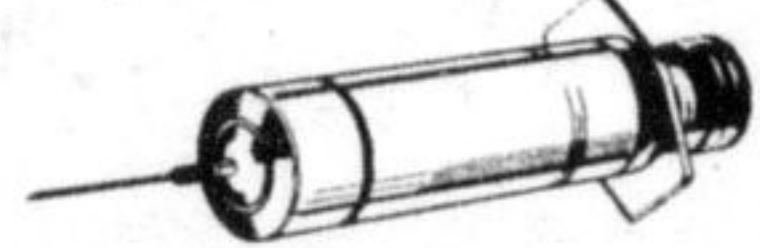

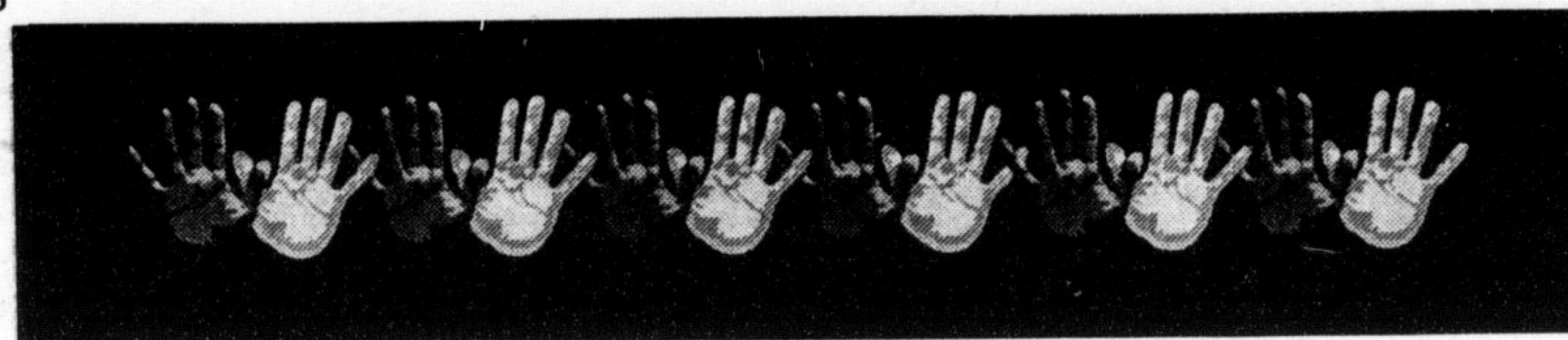

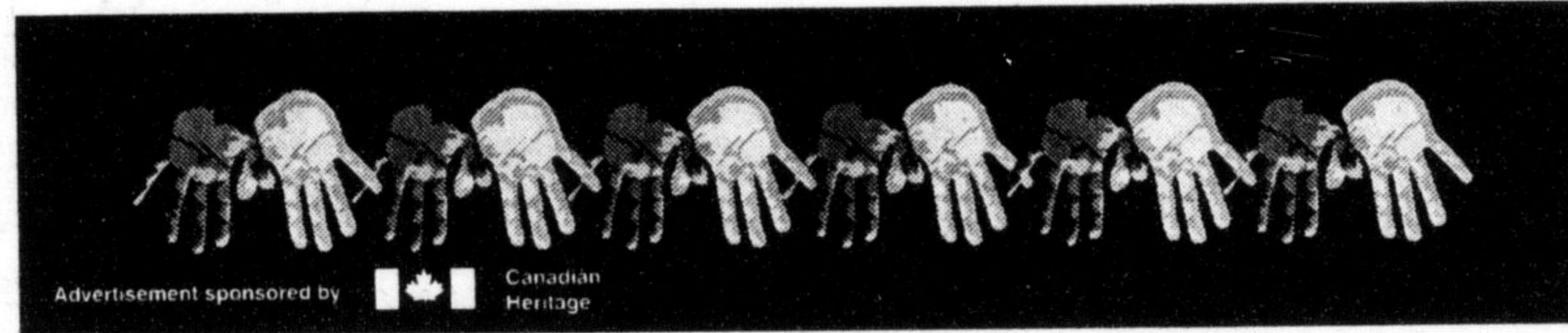

## Hams to test skills

Local ham radio operators will work around the clock to get on the air for the North America-wide Field Day this weekend.

Under primitive conditions, members of the Milton and Royal Bank Employees amateur radio clubs will join forces to contact thousands of other operators in Canada and the United States at the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Days Saints retreat just off of No. 3 Sideroad in Campbellville.

The nation's largest ham radio on-air event is the annual "shakedown run" for the American Radio Relay League (ARRL) and Radio Amateurs of Canada (RAC), said Danny Huton, Royal Bank Employees Amateur Radio Club president.

"Field Day is a way for hams to get outdoors and have fun

under some difficult conditions, but it's also a chance to fine-tune emergency communication skills," he said.

"We use generators and battery power, and we set up antennas in the field. The idea is to put together a self-sufficient, working station quickly and begin making contacts."

The ARRL and RAC have been effective in establishing emergency communication during floods, hurricanes, fires, earthquakes and other major disasters, Mr. Huton said.

Set up will begin at 10 a.m. Saturday followed by on air operation at 2 p.m. The event will wrap up Sunday at 2 p.m.

further meeting with the HRCA is scheduled for next week.

Mr. Krantz said various aspects of water quality were looked at in 1992 when \$600,000 was spent on improving the pond area. He pointed out that so many agencies became involved, including the Ministry of Natural Resources, that it was decided to spend the money on land surrounding the pond. A four-year water study was started in 1996 but did not survive budget cuts in 1997.

"At this time of year the pond is a mess, it stinks in fact," said Mr. Krantz. "We need to have the Ministry of Natural Resources involved no matter how many dollars we are willing to spend."

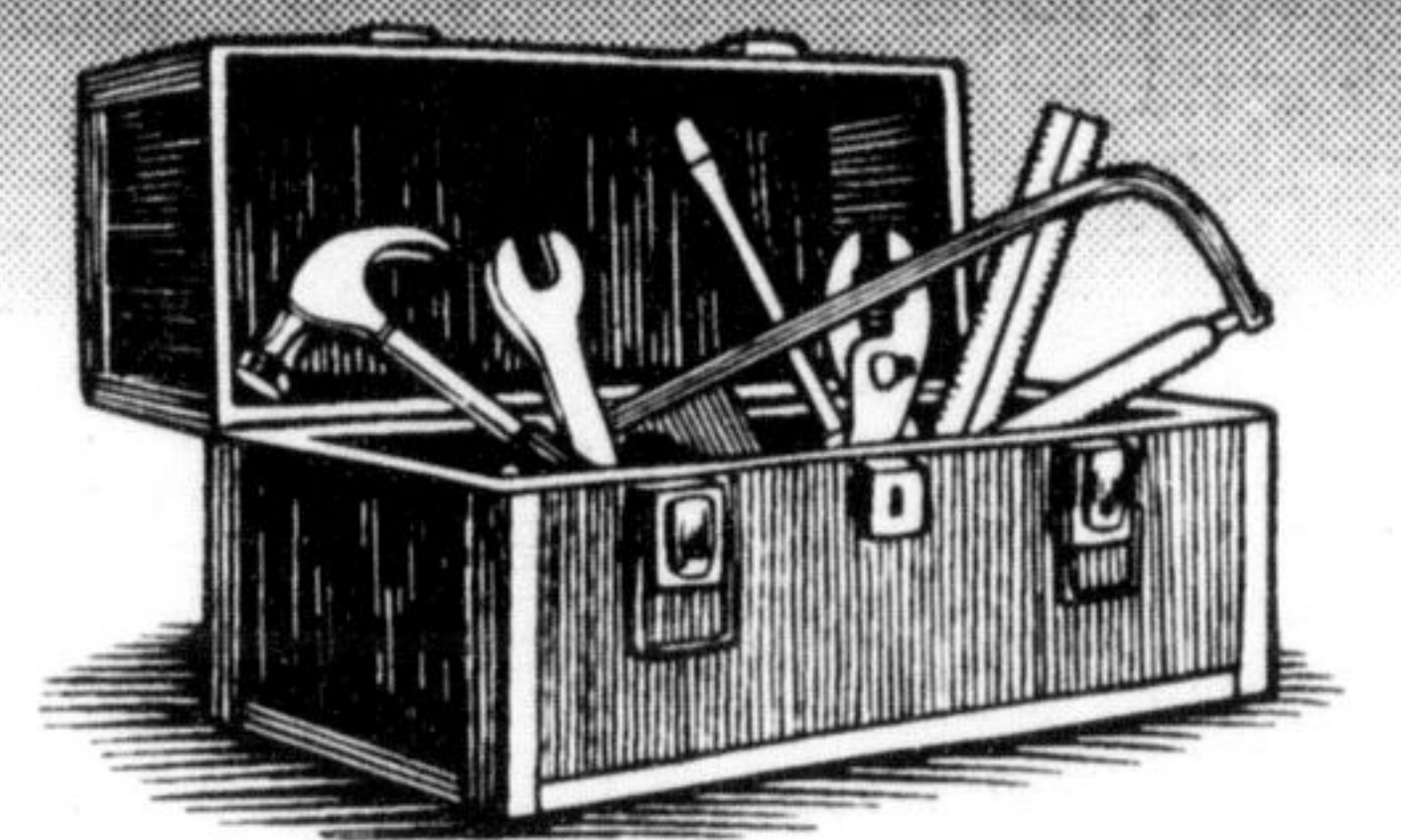
