Payback is more than decisive

Revenge may be a dish best served cold, but the under-15 boys soccer team was absolutely sizzling during payback time last Tuesday at Thompson South. Milton scored an unbelievable and unprecedented 10 goals to Saltfleet's one, avenging their only loss of the season last

month. "This had to have been a career high for them," said first-year coach Adrian Wood, whose team sits second in the South Region Soccer League (SRSL) with a 3-1-2 record. "With players injured or on vacation

Turning in near flawless goaltending was Robin Holt.

The Wallace Pontiac-sponsored team will be minus several players including a vacationing Samson tonight (Tuesday) when they battle league-leader St. Catharines for top spot in the SRSL.

In an effort to fill the gap coach Wood has called up well-regarded Frank Fazio from the houseleague ranks.

Comeback kid

Andrea Cooney notched her third hat-trick of the season to deliver her under-19 Magic girls a 4-3 comeback over the Burlington Boltz Thursday at Thompson North.

Three opposing defenders draped themselves all over the local sharpshooter in the dying moments of the game but she still managed to find a hole and belt one last shot that trickled off the goalie's hands and hit mesh to snap the tie.

Skipper Bert Zonneveld said the shot was "one even the guys at the World Cup would have been proud of."

Also instrumental in the rally was striker Kim Langevin, while Angie Van Egmond gave a standout defensive effort in support of goalkeeper Alana Loiselle.

Showing strongly in midfield was Andrea Dafoe.

The win — which upped their record to 3-4 — was payback for previous one-goal losses to Burlington in regular season and league cup play.

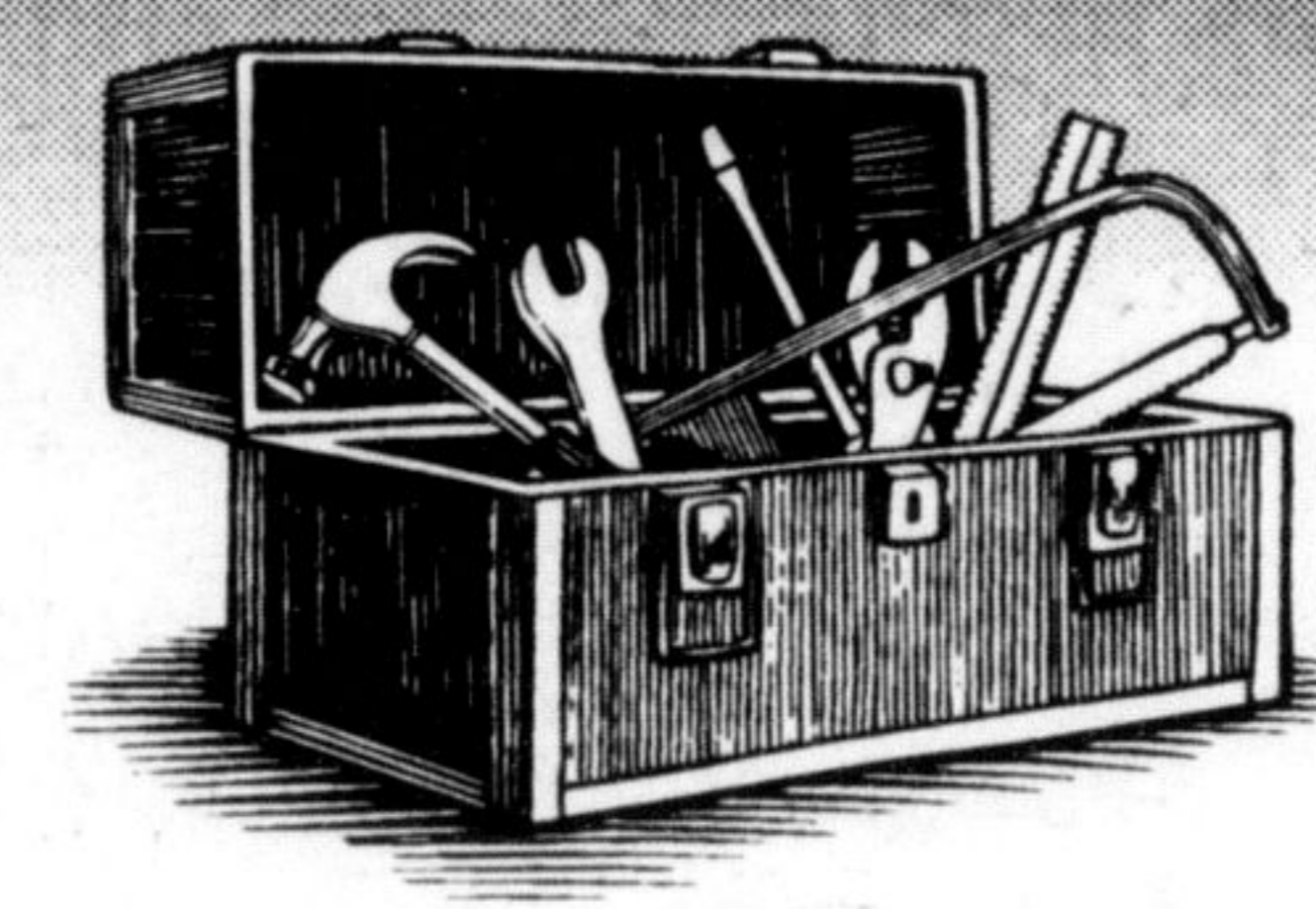
