DO'GREECE!

THERE ARE MANY WAYS TO SEE
GREECE – the City of ATHENS is a
spectacular visit in itself; plus many
CRUISESHIPS make their way among
the 100s of islands which make up this
historic country; there are a variety of
FERRY BOATS zigzagging island to
island; and, of course, there are FLIGHTS
to some of the larger islands from the
mainland; or one can hitch a ride on a
SAILBOAT to make their way across the
open waters to visit yet another island –
each of which has its own identity and
personality, with memories for all in a
variety of sources.



WE CHOSE THE SAILBOAT AS 'THE WAY TO GO!' for a recent twoweek venture - we called it a 'once-in-alifetime' trip, but now are convinced we would love to go again! The good part of going on a sailboat is you can get to some of the smaller islands to explore, where the large cruiseships cannot get into and even the ferries do not serve regularly. From the ACROPOLIS in Athens, to the island of AEGINA and its TEMPLE OF APHAIA; onwards to POROS, to HYDRA, to KLEFTIKO, to HYDRA, to IOS (with a side trip by ferry to SANTORINI!) to PAROS, to MYKONOS (of course!), to KEA, and finally back to the mainland at CAPE SOUNION - what an adventure! And at each stop it was like a whole new country to explore.



IF YOU HAVE BEEN TO BRITISH COLUMBIA and used their ferry service to the various points, both on the mainland and the islands, you will understand the excellent method of 'getting about' there is - it is very similar in Greece. A GREAT 'WAY TO GO' we met people who were going island to island via the ferry route, travelling on their own timespan, visiting the sites, tasting the local flavours; then going to the pier, getting on the ferry (there are really fast 'hydrofoils' or the regular ferries which carry people, cars and cargo) and moving on to the next venture - another island, another memorable visitation!
