



The Foodland store in the Campbellville Country Meadows plaza is hosting an art show Saturday and Sunday.


"Recently we approached a few artists we met at a show organized by the Milton Fine Arts Society and inquired if they would be interested," said store co-owner Marlene Cristello.

The plaza is in downtown Campbellville just west of Guelph Line




