

## Two fishing lines allowed

Anglers may now use two lines while fishing from a boat in the open waters of most of Lake Ontario.

The Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters supports the change.

Anglers are allowed to fish with two lines in New York State waters of Lake Ontario, as well as the open waters of Lake Erie.

The Fish and Wildlife Advisory Board recommended the change to the Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR).

"MNR developed a new regulation allowing anglers to use two lines to help make the fishing experience for salmon and trout anglers even more satisfying on Lake Ontario," said Natural Resources Minister John Snobelen.

Anglers may use two lines from a boat in divisions two and eight, except in the Bay of Quinte, Presqu'ile Bay, Wellers Bay, East Lake, West Lake, Frenchman's Bay, Hamilton Harbour and all tributaries of Lake Ontario.

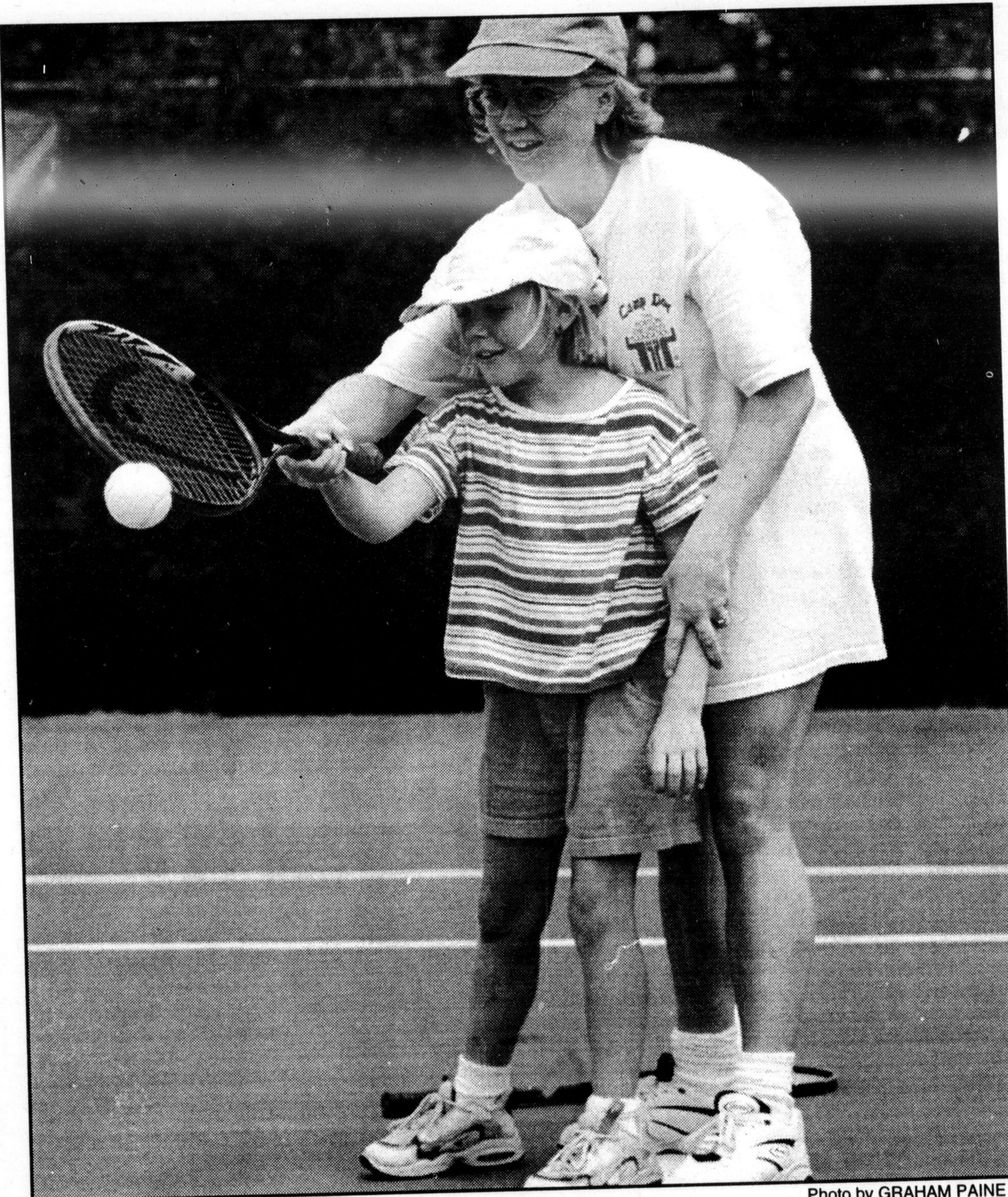

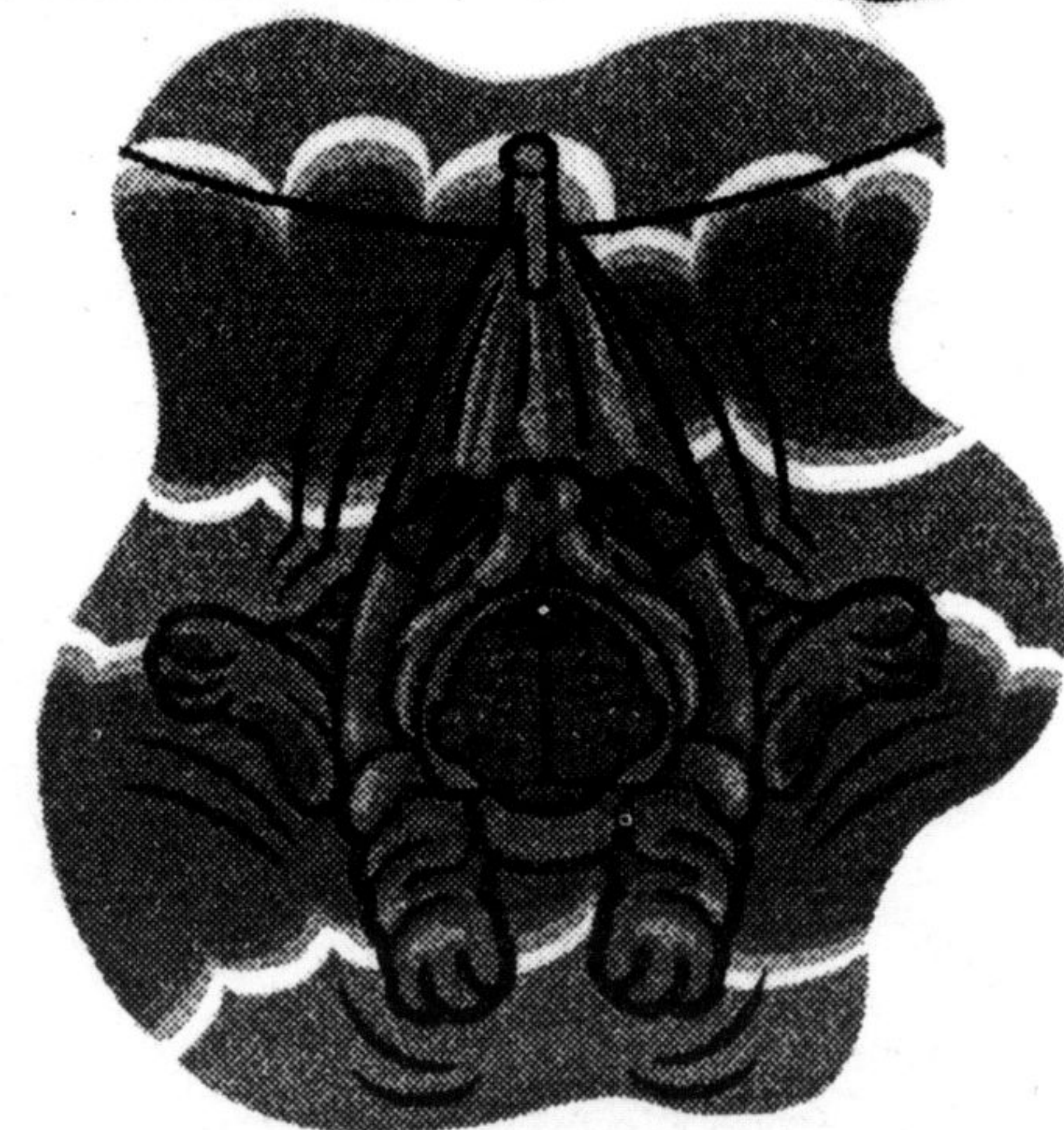
