## Sweethearts broken in semifinals

The Milton Sweethearts were all slugged out.

After a highly explosive round-robin campaign, the local mosquito girls baseball team just couldn't sustain their power in semifinal play and bowed out of the provincial championships last weekend in Mississauga.

They were hammered 18-4 by Ajax in the final four contest Sunday, with only Erin Baker able to contribute offensively. She collected three hits, including a double, and drove in two of the four runs.

The previous day Milton amassed a whopping 36 runs and won two of three games en route to a playoff berth.

Their bats spoke loudest against North Bay, who were outdistanced 17-11 — due in large part to a 4-for-4 hitting clinic by Katie Wollaston.

Justine Williams had a season high five RBI, driving in runs by way of a single, walk and pair of sacrifice flies.

The Sweethearts needed every bit of their offensive talent to squeak by Simcoe 15-14 in opening round action. Joanne Kenealy lashed out a double to right field in the sixth — her third hit of the game — which brought home the tying and go-ahead runs.

Scoring were Amanda Rankin and Jan Wollaston.

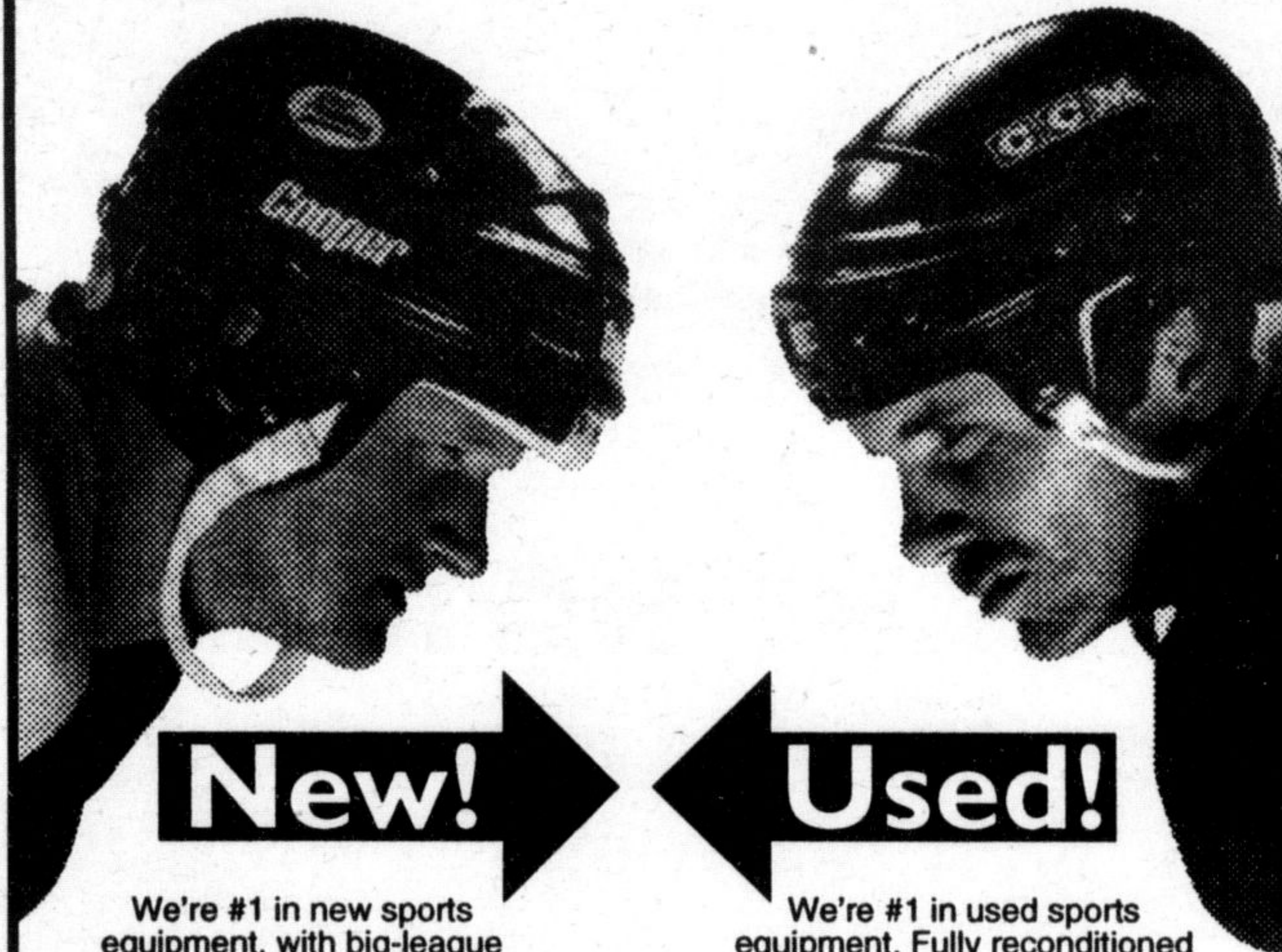
Another three-hit effort was recorded by Janet Adams while Laura Wellstead contributed some effective middle relief pitching.

Milton's only round-robin loss came to Mississauga, whose pitchers restricted them to four hits in a 14-4 drubbing.

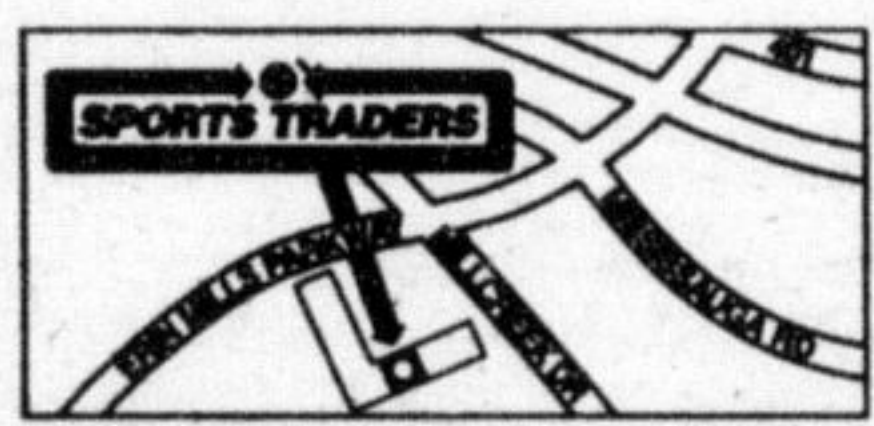

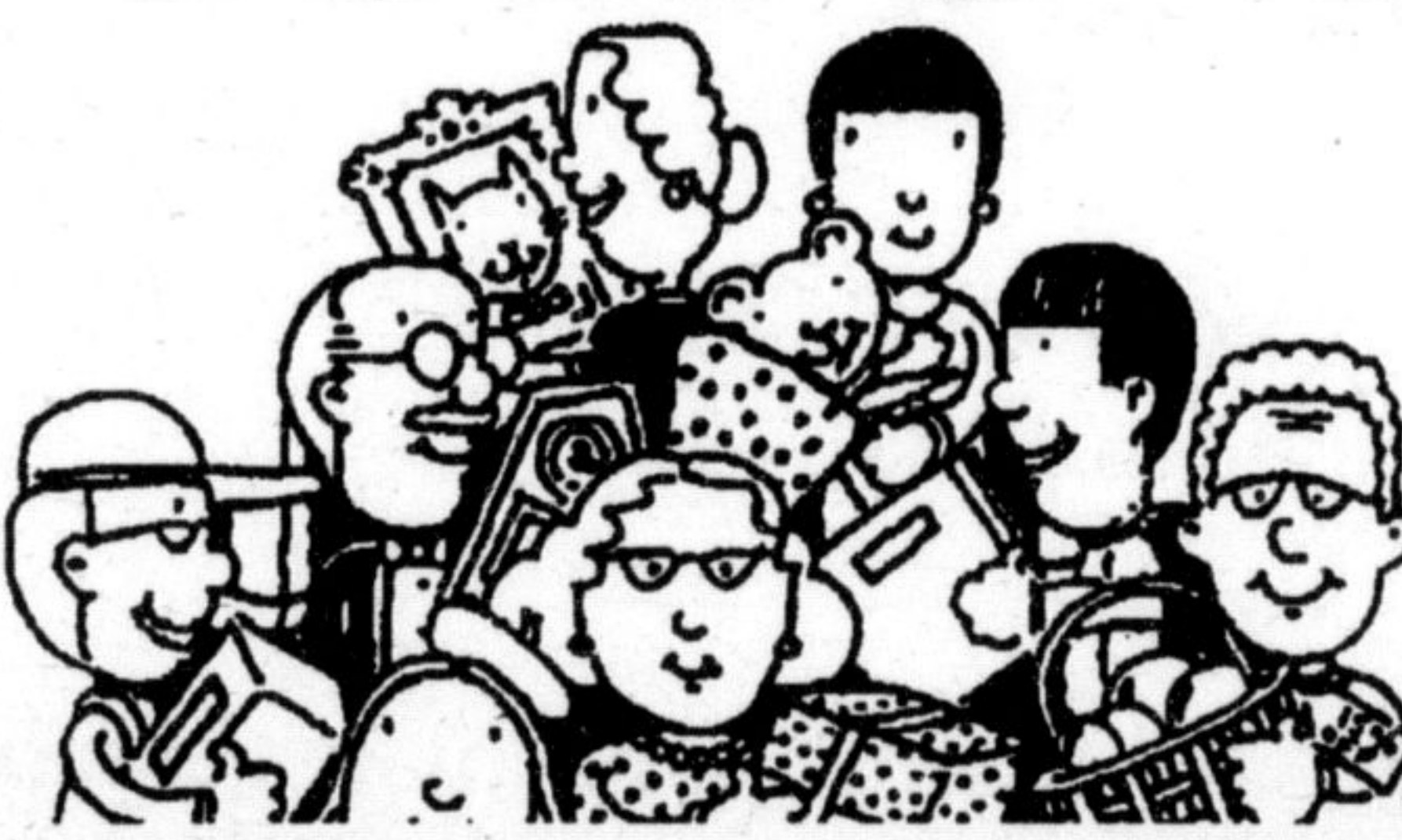
