# Library gets \$52,000 grant from provincial Tories

Milton Public Library recently received its 1998 provincial grant of \$52,429.

According to Leslie Fitch, Milton Public Library's chief executive officer and chief librarian, the grant is determined on a per capita basis. Ms Fitch said the province sees the money as a way to promote resource sharing partnerships between libraries.

While the money is simply added to the library's operating budget, it does allow telecommunication projects which extend the local library's capabilities, she said.

"It's an acknowledgment by the province that we need partnering for other resources," Ms Fitch said.

Last year the provincial government was considering getting out of funding for local

libraries however, they decided in November to continue their grant program.

Ms Fitch said the Milton library was never in a financial crisis regarding the grant, so it is difficult to say what program specifically might have been cut if the money was not forthcoming.

Halton North MPP Ted Chudleigh said through the grant the provincial government is attempting to support libraries in smaller communities.

"The partnership between our government and the public library service is an integral part of Ontario's communities," said Mr. Chudleigh.

"I look forward to strengthening that alliance and providing quality library services for another successful year."
