

Liberals will host lectures on business in Burlington

The Ontario Liberal Party will host several lectures on issues concerning business.

The first, entitled "How the 1999 Provincial Election Will Affect You" will take place at the Burlington Golf and Country Club on Northshore Boulevard on Thursday, Oct. 8 at 6 p.m.

The lecture will feature Philip Olsson, co-head and co-managing director of Royal Bank Equity Partners, speaking on economic issues in the context of Ontario

history.

He will also provide an economic forecast and discuss how key election issues might affect Ontario business.

Mr. Olsson began work as an investment banker for Pitfield Mackay Ross in 1979. He later moved to the Royal Bank's Dominion Securities operations in Alberta, where he managed initial public offerings of TELUS Corporation in 1990 and Petro Canada in 1991.

He holds BA and MBA degrees from Vanderbilt University and has pursued postgraduate research at the London School of Economics.

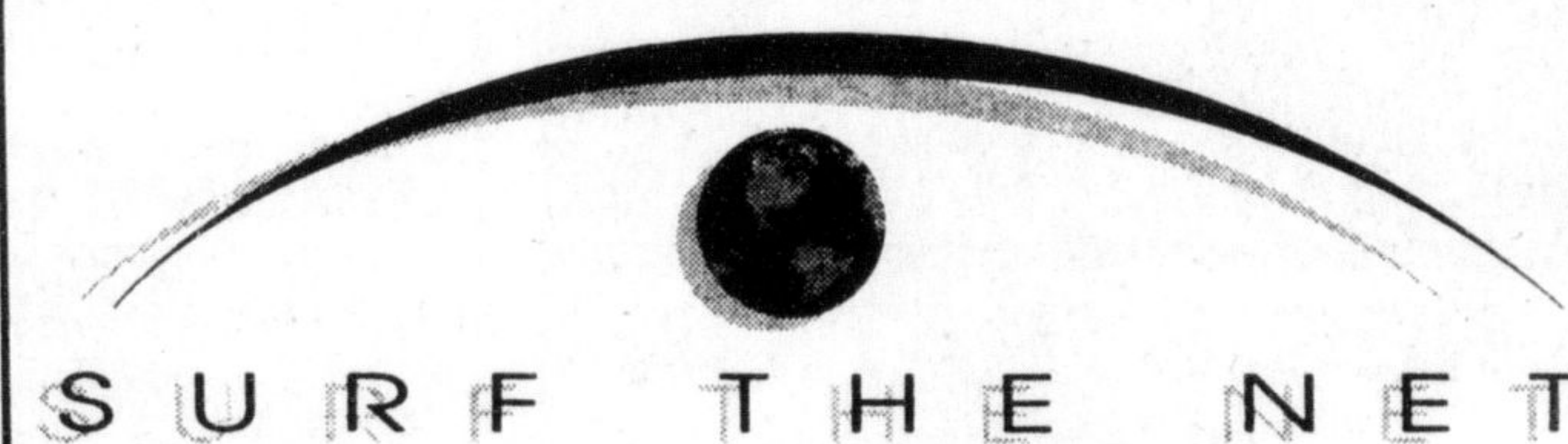
