

Sox make early exit from tourney

The Milton Red Sox suffered through extra-inning heartbreak on the way to an early exit from the Central Ontario Baseball Association (COBA) championship tournament in Burlington.

An opening round 11-inning marathon with Kitchener — which spanned two days — ended in a 6-5 loss for the local minor midgets, who just couldn't sustain their offensive pressure down the stretch.

The score was knotted at five after seven frames Friday night, when the game was put over to the following morning.

Jarrett Konkle, Kevin Cooper and Nathan Perrott combined for a sound pitching performance.

The loss put Milton on the critical condition list in the double knockout tournament.

They did manage to prolong their season a little with a convincing 9-5 triumph over Guelph. Breaking things open in the sixth was Perrott, who crushed an opposite field

grand slam homer. Showing strongly on the mound were Cooper and Mike Grabauskas.

A couple of hours later the Red Sox fell 7-2 to the Brampton Royals, who were a thorn in their side all season long. Memories of repeated losses to their Peel Region rivals plus fatigue from playing one-and-a-half games earlier in the day proved to be too much for the locals to overcome.

Splitting the pitching duties were Konkle, Cooper and Michael Volpe.

There's reason to grin, but just barely

It was by the slimmest of margins but Grinfromeartear — the prohibitive choice — got the job done in last Saturday's \$600,100 Metro Pace, Canada's richest event for two-year-olds.

At the wire, Grinfromeartear, driven by Luc Ouellette, could afford a tiny smile as he hung on gamely to edge locally owned Barnett Hanover by a nose.

Island Fantasy was just a hair back — finishing in 1:52.4 for third — while Robust Art helped round out a four-way photo finish.

Like father, like son, Grinfromeartear duplicated the feat of his sire Artsplace, winner of the 1990 Metro Pace. But it sure wasn't easy, as the colt showed a championship heart in keeping his career record at an unblemished 6-0.

It was the second time this season he managed to eclipse Barnett Hanover, who's owned by Hornby breeder John Grant and was one of the favourites in the lucrative Woodbine race.

After taking command before the half-mile, Grinfromeartear enjoyed a comfortable lead past the three-quarter mark when

the challenges began. First came Island Fantasy roaring up on the outside, turning from home to duel the odds-on favourite. Meanwhile Barnett Hanover, enjoying a pocket trip, looked for room on the rail.

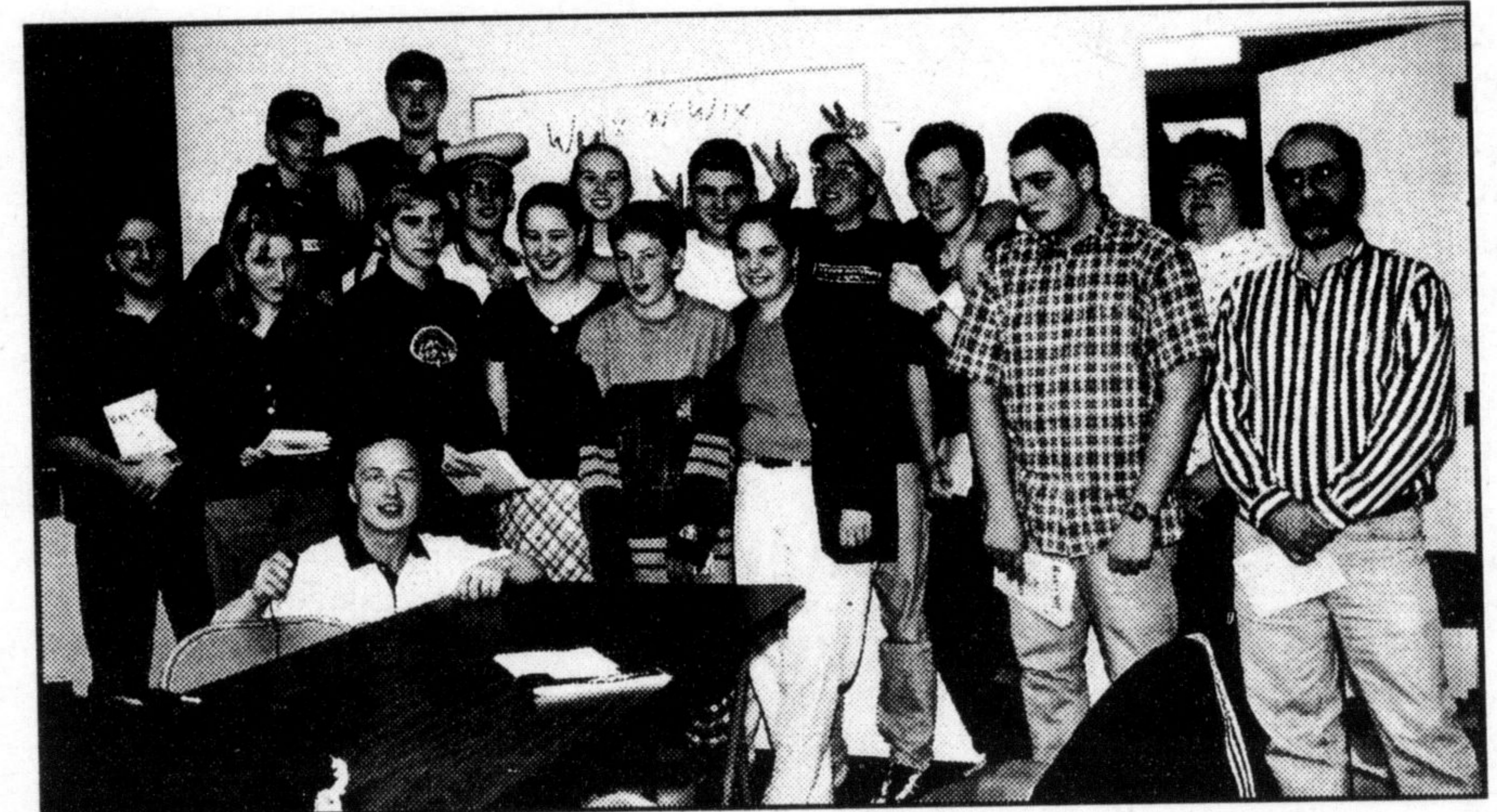
Long shot Robust Art then made a threatening move down the middle of the track.

In the deep stretch, it looked like the Metro would once again by a graveyard for favourites, but Grinfromeartear repulsed all comers and had just enough left in the tank to hold off Barnett Hanover.

"He's a great horse," said Ouellette. "He's already shown that before, whether he races from behind or whatever. Tonight he had to do most of the work. He was running out of gas tonight. I knew I had a horse outside of me and the horse inside (Barnett Hanover) had a better trip than me."

Added trainer Duane Marfisi. "I'm going to give him six weeks off, then aim for the Breeders Crown and Governor's Cup."
