

# Rural house broken into on Derry near Twiss

Detectives in Milton are searching for clues to the identity of the person responsible for the daytime entry at a rural residence last month.

The owner left his home on Derry Road near Twiss Road at 9:15 a.m. Friday, Aug. 21.

When he returned at 6:15 p.m., he discovered someone had forced a side door for the house.

The culprit searched the entire building, ransacking the master bedroom in a quest for valuables.

The items stolen included a Hitachi VCR, a Sony CD player, a Sony AM/FM receiver and a Sony cassette player. The estimated value of the goods was placed at \$1,900.

Given the location of the house and the property stolen, a vehicle of some kind would have been needed.

If you think you can suggest possible suspects for police to investigate, Crime Stoppers wants to hear from you.

If you have any information that leads to an arrest in this or

any other case, you may be eligible for a cash reward of up to \$1,000.

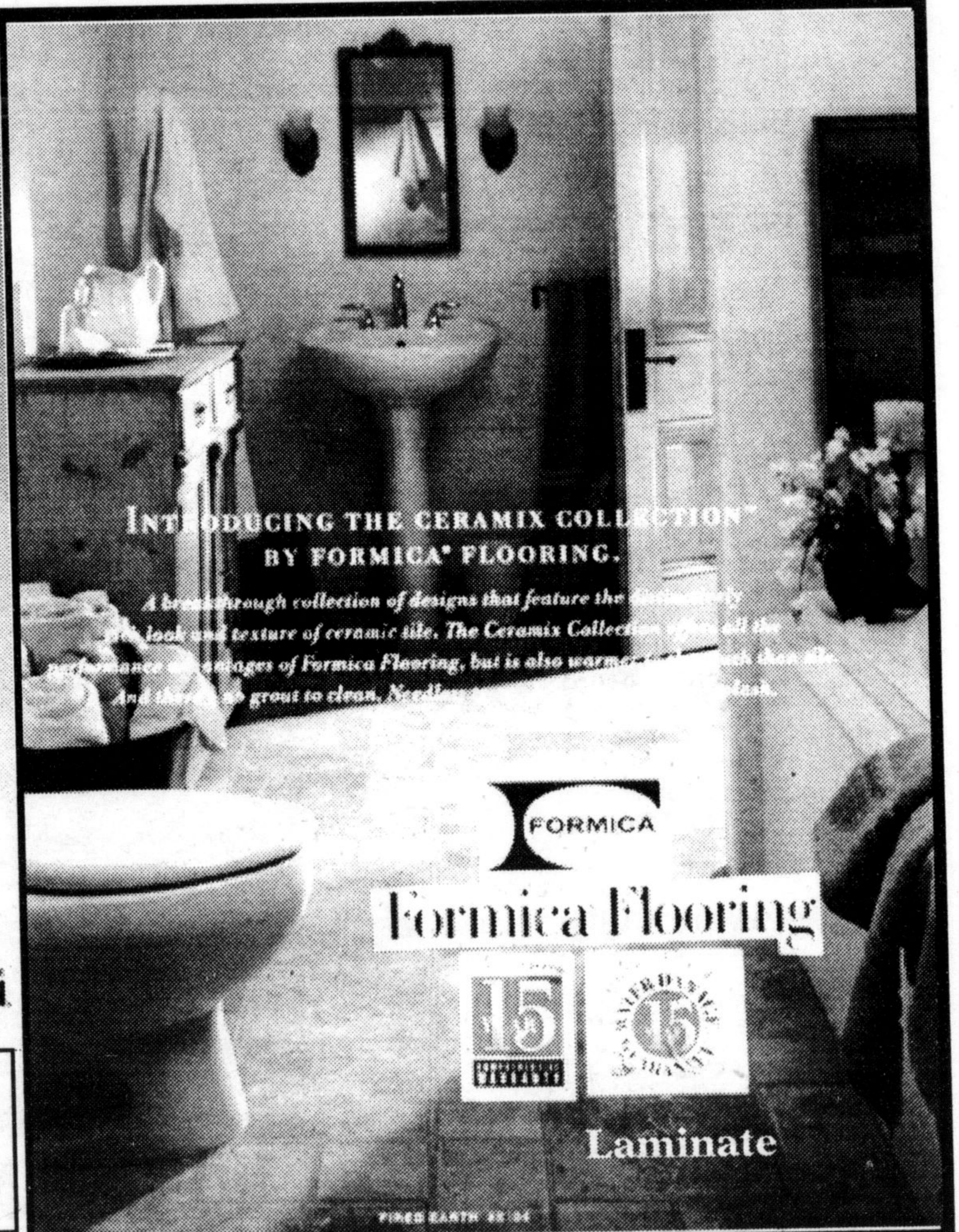

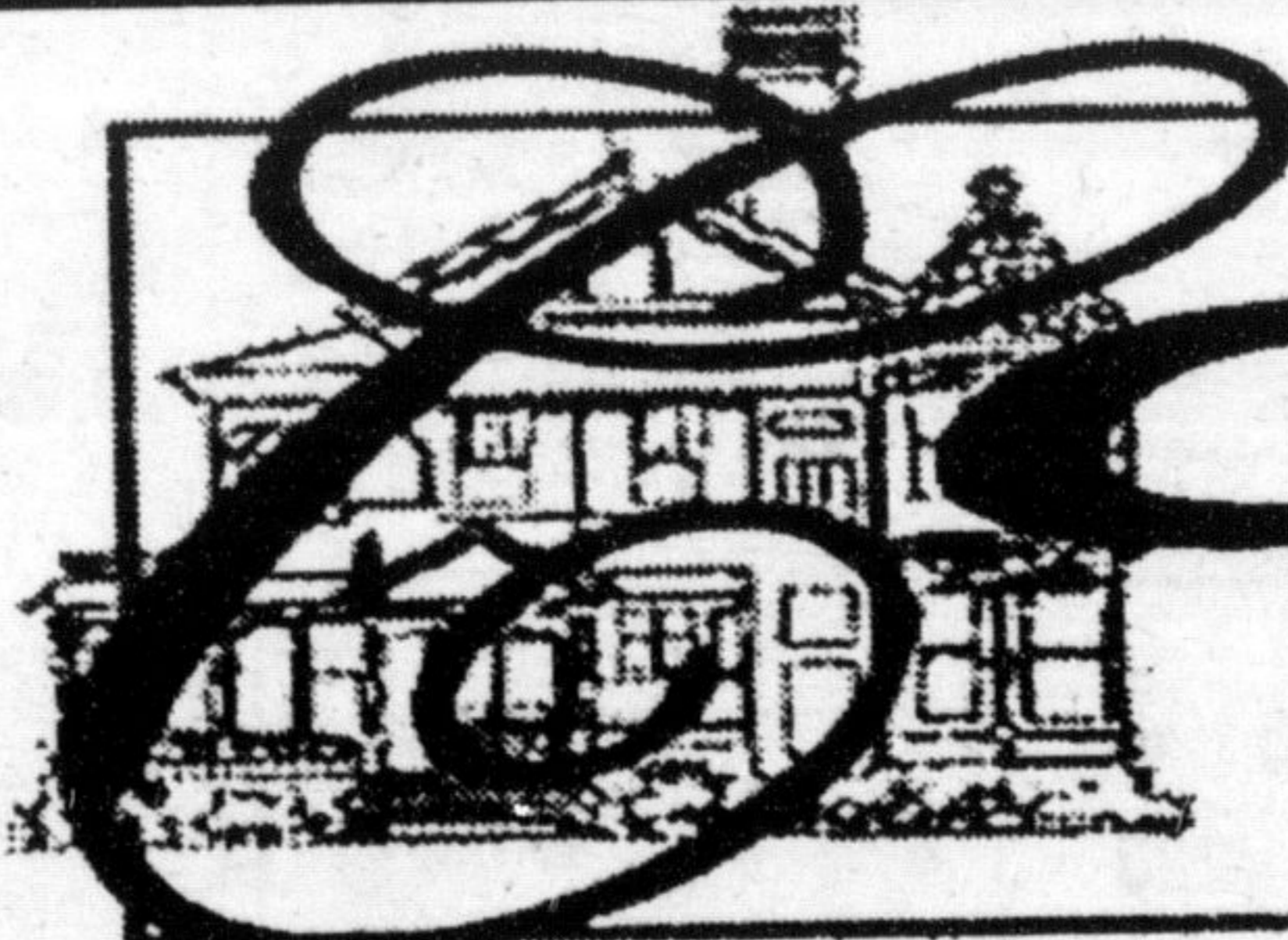
