

People who give money for Mill Pond get tax receipts

Town council agreed to accept all money raised for short and long term solutions to the Mill Pond.

"The rationale behind this is to find a spot to put money and establish a reserve for ongoing maintenance on the pond," said Mr. Hunter.

He explained that a presentation by citizens of Tillsonburg at a recent Mill Pond committee meeting provided a model for fundraising.

Tillsonburg citizens managed to raise \$750,000 to maintain their pond.

According to Mr. McQueen the Town can issue tax receipts for money contributed to a Mill Pond fund.

Council pay

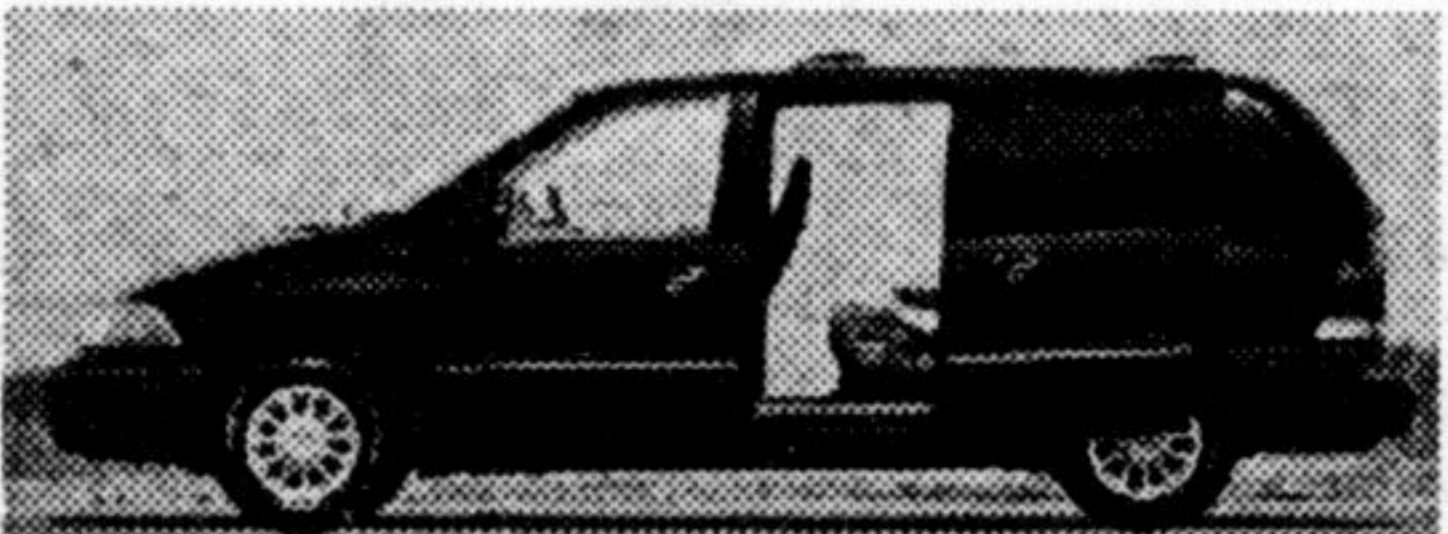
Mr. Challinor told council he will bring forward a motion regarding council pay given the move by the provincial government to end the practice of not taxing one-third of the annual pay.
