Single women becoming more active in real estate

The proportion of single women buying resale homes in Toronto has increased substantially.

The survey analyzed the demographics of thousands of Canadian homebuyers during 1993. It found more single women are buying homes than single men. In fact, Toronto has the second greatest percentage of women buyers in Canada, next to Vancouver.

purchases by singles, close to 4 per cent higher than the major factors influencing activity. However, we last year. Male buyers declined 4 per cent, dropping to 43.2 per cent. As a whole, singles represented 27 per cent of market activity, up 2 per cent over 1992.

There are a number of probable influences behind this trend, including improving income levels, the realization that buying a home is a hedge against rent increases, and social trends like people waiting longer to get married.

Whatever the factors, it's apparent that more and more single women in Toronto now have the motiva-

tion and the capability to buy homes.

The survey also found Toronto leads the country in the number of first-time buyers. They now represent 48 per cent of the market.

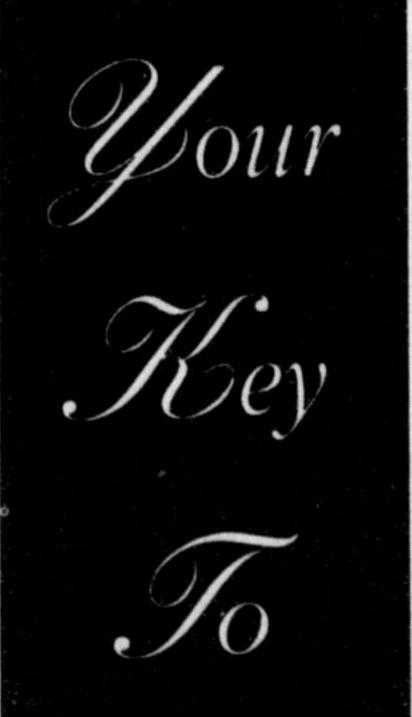
