While Jacques suffered through both losses, two of the three ties came with Wenzel between the pipes.

Each has one shutout while together they've turned in eight one-goal performances.

In the latest of these near-flawless showings Jacques was nearly ideal through the first and final periods. His lone giveaway came at the tail end of the second to Mark Mazzetti.

Milton fired 53 shots the other way but were largely ineffective against veteran cager Jamie Bachorski, who stopped all 19 shots in the opening frame and did a great job keeping his Kilty Bees in the game.

Ryan Eby, Nathan Gillies, Chris Rowan and Geoff Schomogyi were the marksmen, with Ryan Robichaud drawing two assists.

Playing against his ex-teammates for the first time, scoring leader Ed McGrane helped set up the game-winning goal.

Among those in on a little brawling action were 14-year-old rookie Adam Sturgeon and star blueliner Matt Bannan, who got the better of Mike Burgoyne to preserve his unblemished fight record.

The Merchants' defensive unit showed strongly and created a lot of quality scoring chances.

Tuesday at home they managed an identical number of shots and improved to 27-2-3 — still tops in the West.

Bannan used his fierce slapshot to drive a couple of nails in Niagara's coffin. Also tallying twice was Gillies, who buried the biscuit with upstairs wristers — the first time on a picturesque coast-to-coast rush.

Singles went to captain Kevin O'Flaherty and Mike Wheelihan. Dropping back to the blueline, in light of a one-night defensive shortage (Ryan Carrigan was suspended and Chris Bahen was

fighting illness), Dave Csumrik made great passes all night and finished with three helpers.

In the only noteworthy fight of the game — attended by a precious few fans — Robichaud pummeled Mike Drezek although both were assessed only double-minor roughing infractions by referee Ron MacLean.

Merchant notes: Ed McGrane, Kevin O'Flaherty and Geoff Schomogyi all sit top eight in West Conference scoring with 66, 65 and 63 points respectively ... Nathan Gillies recently surpassed the half-century points mark. He and fellow sophomore Mike Wheelihan remain contenders for the Most Improved Player award ... The Merchants host Oakville tonight and finish 1998 league play with road trips to Niagara and Burlington early next


