Ryan Hayward, also in his final year at Assumption, said OAC students are concerned that they aren't being properly prepared for university, particularly in courses like math.

"(The board) is talking about hours being met and credits being received, but they're not talking about what we're learning," said Ms Baker angrily.

Under provincial regulations, students must receive 110 hours of instruction in a course before they are eligible to be granted a credit.

The board's plan has pushed first semester exams back by a week, in order to allow for five special makeup days.

Several scheduled professional development days between now and the end of the year will become regular instructional days to gain time in the second semester.

The plan was approved by the parent and student councils at each of the five Catholic high schools in Halton, although the union representing the high school teachers is angry a program was designed without their consent.
