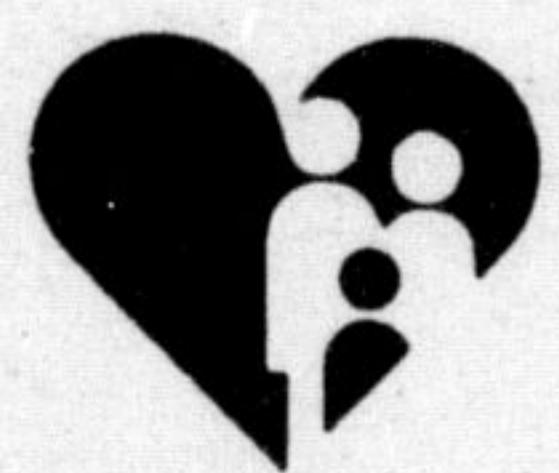

Having secured council approval, Easter Seal fundraising will get into gear with a mail campaign in early March.

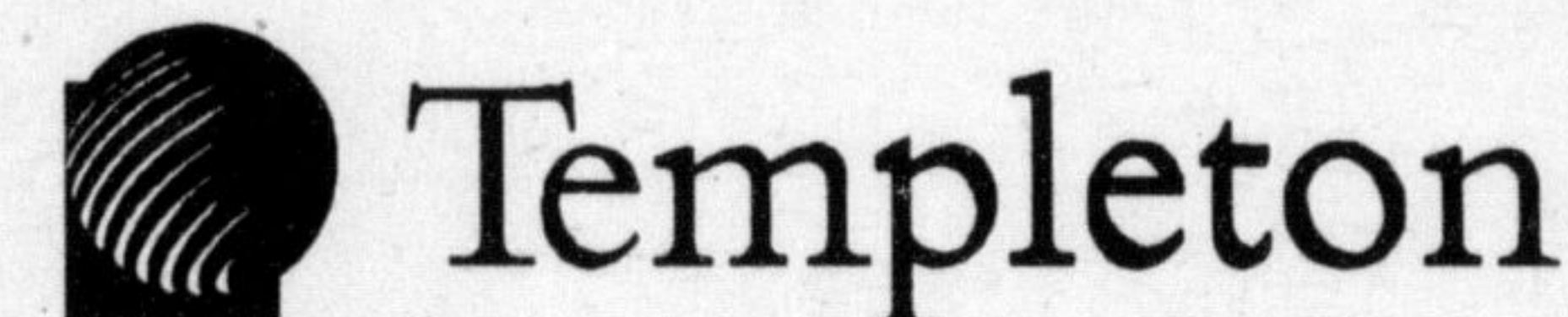
Rotary will also be hosting a murder mystery and Caribbean dinner dance fundraiser.
