possible, however, without the pressure of the lockout followed by intense, realistic negotiations and "major concessions" by the union.

Until that point, Mr. Sherlock maintains, the gap of understanding by teachers about the board's true financial situation was simply too wide. Mr. Sherlock said teachers finally realized that the concessions specifically freezing their salaries for two years — were needed to work out any meaningful deal.

Until the lockout, Mr. Sherlock of-eight workload. explained, teachers kept asking why the Halton board couldn't forge an agreement similar to that worked out in Hamilton-Wentworth. The main difference there, said Mr. Sherlock, was a salary freeze.
