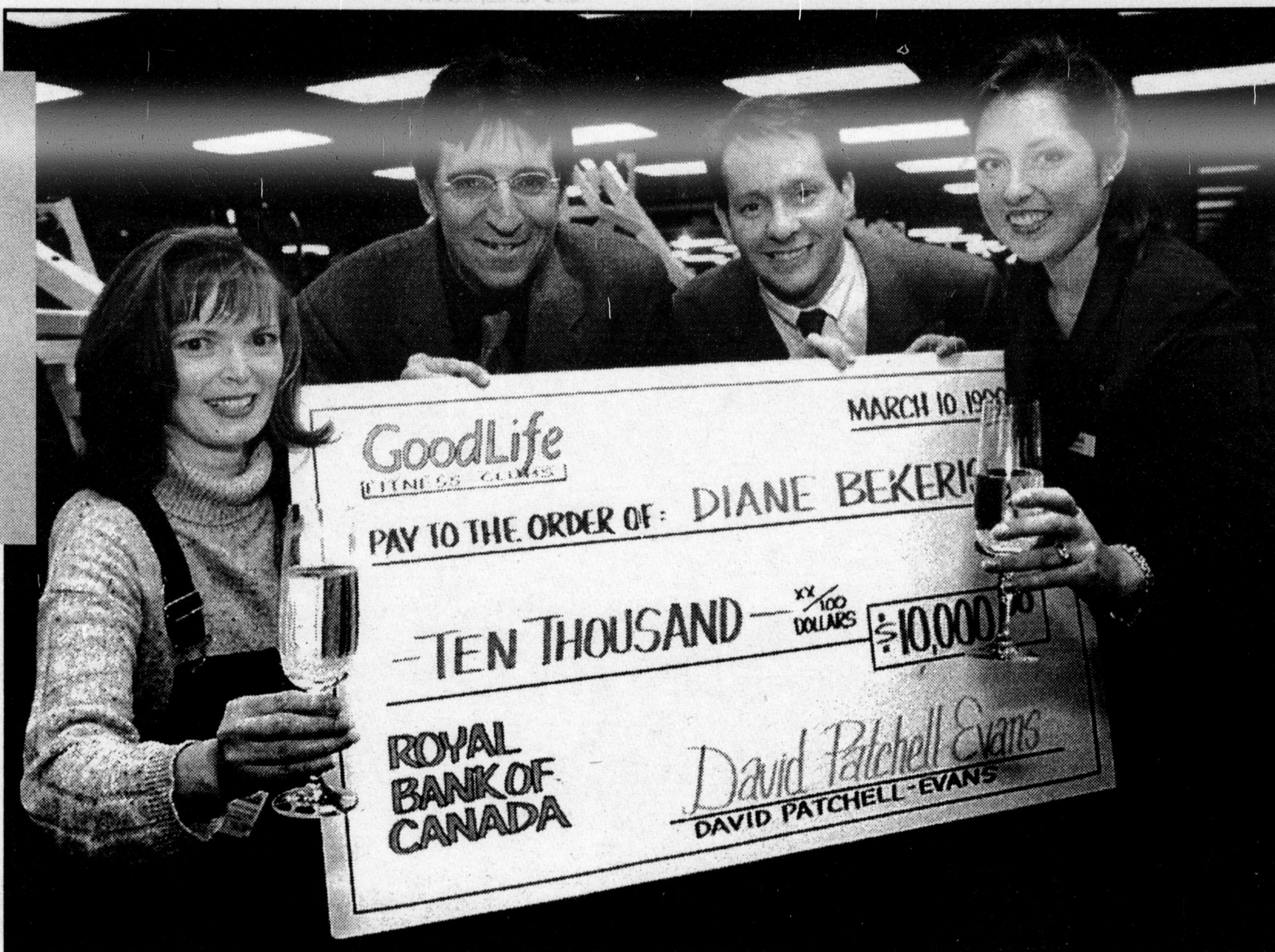


She hits the jackpot

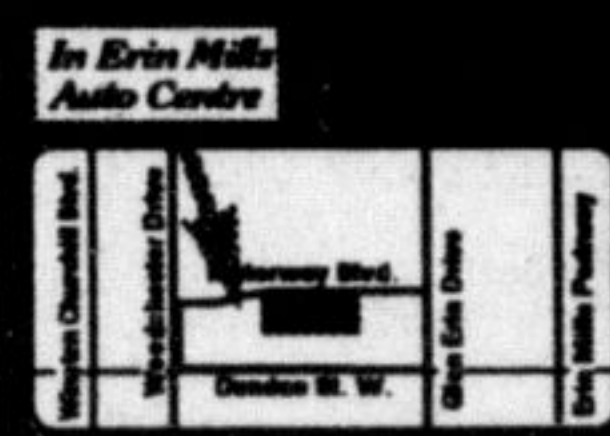

The Oakville branch of the Canadian Red Cross Society hosts an **open house** featuring information on the home support programs and services provided by the

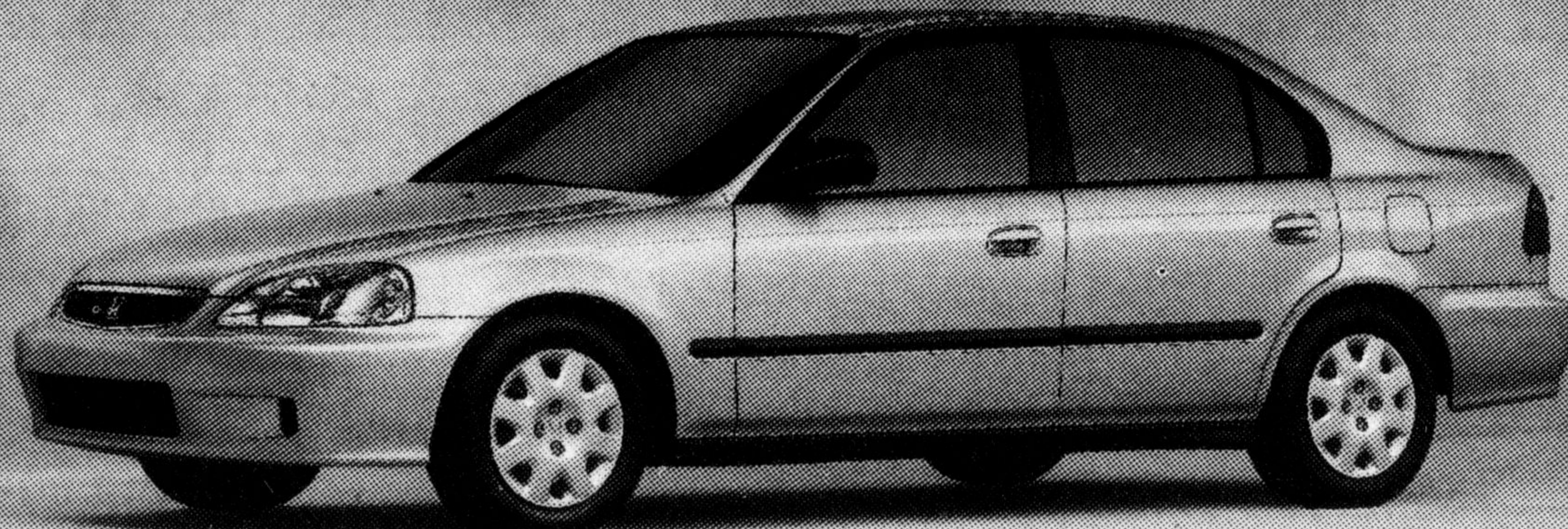

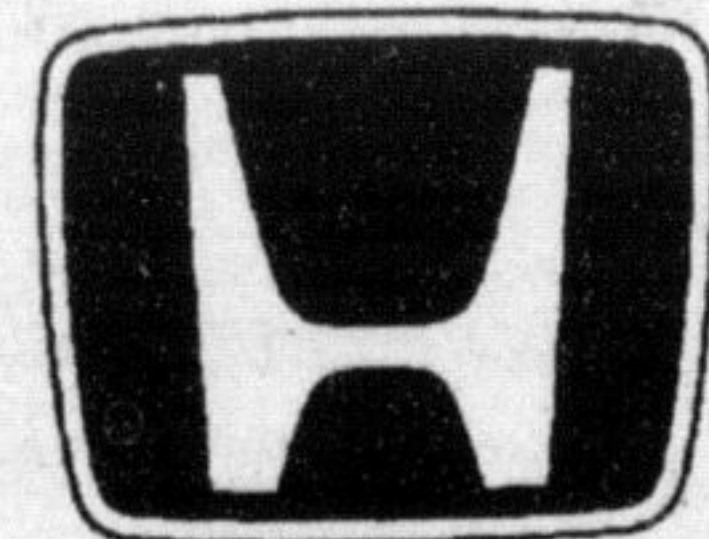
