Three years ago Liz and Clem Scholtz asked Miltonians to help save their daughter's life. Now, they want to hear from everyone who did.

It's hard to believe, the couple said, that so much time has passed since their little Deidre was first diagnosed with aplastic anemia — which threatened to take her life until a bone marrow match was found and a successful transplant was performed in the spring of 1996.

They also admitted that the overwhelming wave of support by the community — which raised more than \$100,000 for the local family and pulled off the largest single family bone marrow clinic in

Said Ms Scholtz, "We have been keeping a book for Deidre, but now would like to add your memo-


ries. Please write and tell us what you did to help and how it affected you and your family.

"If you do not wish your name to be used just state so in your letter and we will honor your wish-






