

# Thieves have been working in downtown core

Halton Regional Police are investigating an office building break-in at Carriage Square in which six businesses were targeted during the daylight hours Sunday.

Sometime between 3 and 8 p.m. at Milton's former Town Hall — a historic building situated in front of Carriage Square on Main Street — thieves forced open a side door and made off with about \$16,000 worth of property.

Three of the six businesses — Foundation Business Development Inc., Kerr Realty Management Ltd. and Derlan Aerospace — sustained losses of computer equipment.

## Police Blotter

The three other offices, including the Milton Chamber of Commerce and Milton Downtown Business Improvement Area, had their doors kicked in, but nothing was stolen.

### Break-ins linked

It's likely the same thieves are responsible for an office break-ins overnight April 8 at 310 Main St. E., said Det. Sgt. Jackie Gordon.

Between 6:30 p.m. and 6 a.m., computer equipment was stolen from EDU Services Inc. and Acumen Inc. after a glass door was smashed.

### Bar targeted in heist

The Nascar Pit Sports Bar was the target of thieves overnight Sunday. The culprits broke in and made off with \$8,700 worth of property.

The thieves forced open the wooden front doors and stole cash, liquor and cigarettes, including 200 miniature bottles of liquor and \$1,000 worth of quarters.

Police are investigating.

### Cars stolen

- A four-door, red 1996 Lexus was stolen from an Esquesing Line driveway overnight Sunday. The vehicle was worth \$20,000.
- A two-door black, 1990 Pontiac Sunbird with the keys left in the ignition was inviting to a thief late Monday afternoon. The vehicle was stolen from the Carriage Square parking lot between 5:15 and 5:30 p.m.

### Drug charges

- Police seized 3 grams of hashish after stopping a 1989 Ford Probe at Steeles Avenue and Peru Road at 11 p.m. Monday. A 38-year-old Paris, Ont. man was charged with possession of a controlled substance.
- A 22-year-old Pitfield Road man and 14-year-old Milton youth face drug charges after police checked a vehicle parked on Pitfield Road at 9:40 p.m. Monday. About 3 grams of marijuana was seized.

### Break-ins at trailers

Thieves made off with \$1,600 worth of equipment after breaking into two trailers at the Holy Rosary School construction site.

Two drills, a saw and portable radios were stolen after the culprits forced open the side doors and cut the locks off the trailers overnight April 8.

### Car stereo stolen

A vacationing man returned home to find that his car had been broken into in the underground garage of a Bronte Street apartment building.

The car's stereo, including speakers, and a baseball glove were taken for a loss of \$1,700.

The incident occurred sometime between March 30 and April 10.

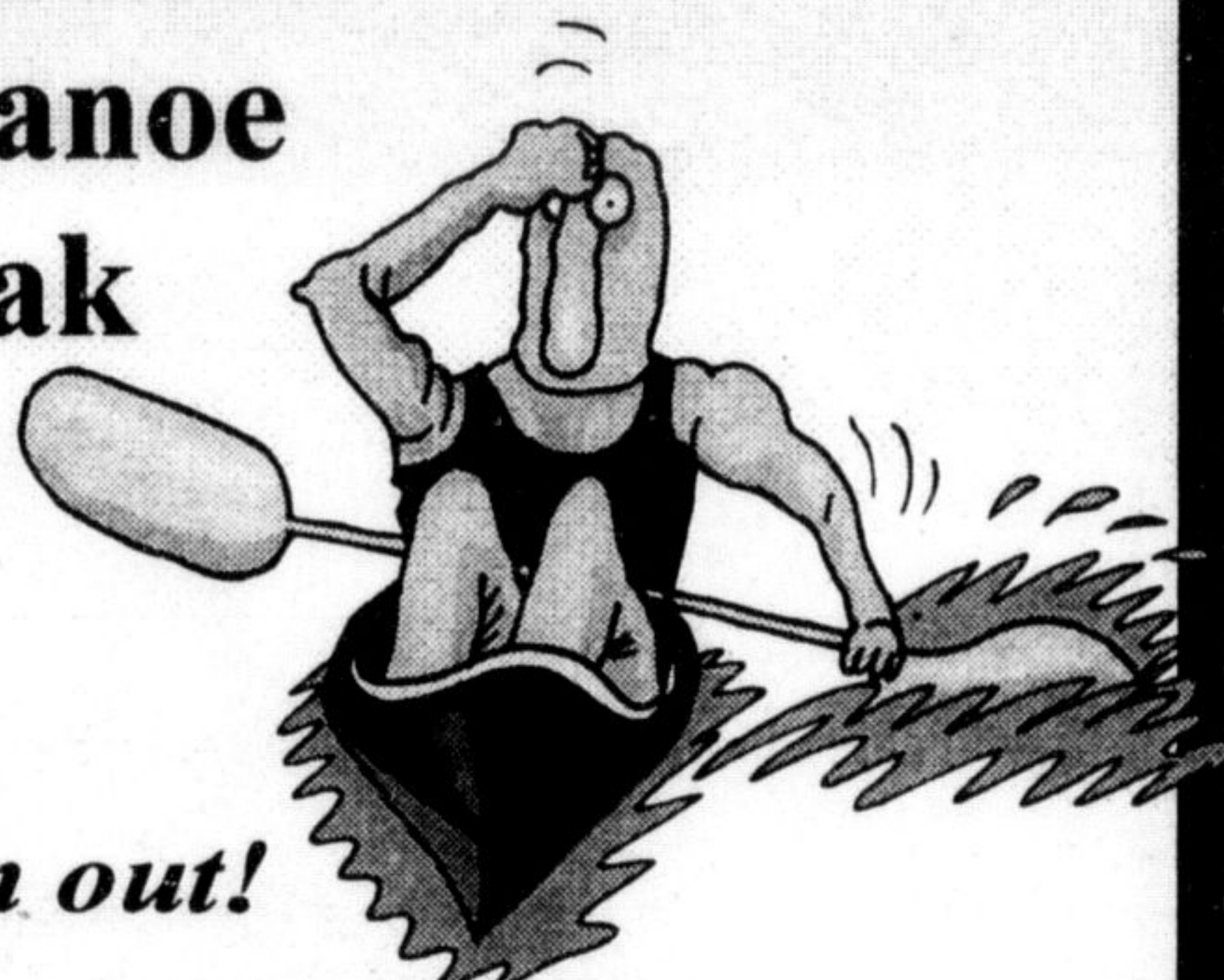
