"Much to our surprise, we did meet twice with the governor and much of our discussion was around economic development," he said. "I really do think there's opportunity there."

While the trio are expected to make a report on any significant issues they feel the Philippine town is facing, final recommendations will be put off until a delegation from Santa Maria arrives in Milton.

"Nothing will be etched in stone as far as what will become of it because we have to wait for their delegation to come back here," said Mr. Krantz.
