


Fish tales

Decision determines destiny! Big doors swing on small hinges! The choices we make today will affect the look of our tomorrow!

In his poem, The Road Not Taken, Robert Frost eloquently writes of walking down a road through a wooded area that suddenly branches out to become two distinct paths. He stands at the fork, wondering which way he should take. He would like to travel both, and tells himself that whichever he chooses he will come back another time to explore the other way. His selection?

Two roads diverged in a wood and I -I took the one less travelled by, And that has made all the difference.

Frost was writing of more than a walk in the woods. he was telling us to seize the opportunities that life presents, to choose our way in life carefully. He was telling us that sometimes we have to abandon the majority and choose the road less travelled.

We must be careful which road we choose. Our selection will determine the course of our life today and our eternal destiny tomorrow. Jesus identifies the two paths in Matthew 7:13-14.

13"Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. 14But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it. (NIV)




