Ups and downs face Turner clan at Ottawa squash tourney

It was a weekend of highs, lows and new beginnings for the Turner clan at the Canadian Junior Squash Championships in Ottawa.

The national tournament — which ran from April 23 to 25 at GoodLife Fitness Centre held something different for each of the three Milton siblings, who have been competing on the court for five years now.

Thirteen-year-old twin brothers Richard and Jonathan took sixth and seventh spot respectively in their final season of under-14 boys play.

This was somewhat disappointing for Richard,

who finished fourth last spring. He was seeded third for this year's event and expected to take the bronze.

Instead he dropped the third round to an opponent from Alberta, whom he'd face two years ago and was confident he could defeat, which crushed his hopes for a medal.

From there Richard won his next match but fell 3-2 in the fifth-place showdown to a Saskatchewan competitor.

"I really thought Richard was better than him (the opponent from Alberta) but it just didn't

come together," said father Ken Turner.

On the other hand, Jonathan was ranked seventh in their division and managed to live up to those expectations — outdistancing a challenger from Manitoba 3-2 in his final match of the weekend.

His efforts, although not overly surprising, were certainly welcomed as he moved up eight spaces from a 14th place finish last year.

Jonathan won his first, third and fifth matches while losing rounds two and four.

A total of 28 topflight competitors took part in

the brothers' age class.

Meanwhile, their little sister Alisha recently turned 12 and moved up to the under-14 girls

She was the youngest entry in the division and pulled off a bit of a shocker by placing eighth out of a field of two dozen gifted players.

Alisha — a bronze medalist in under-12 play last season —dropped the opening round, won the second and then lost the third by a 3-1 margin to an opponent from British Columbia.
