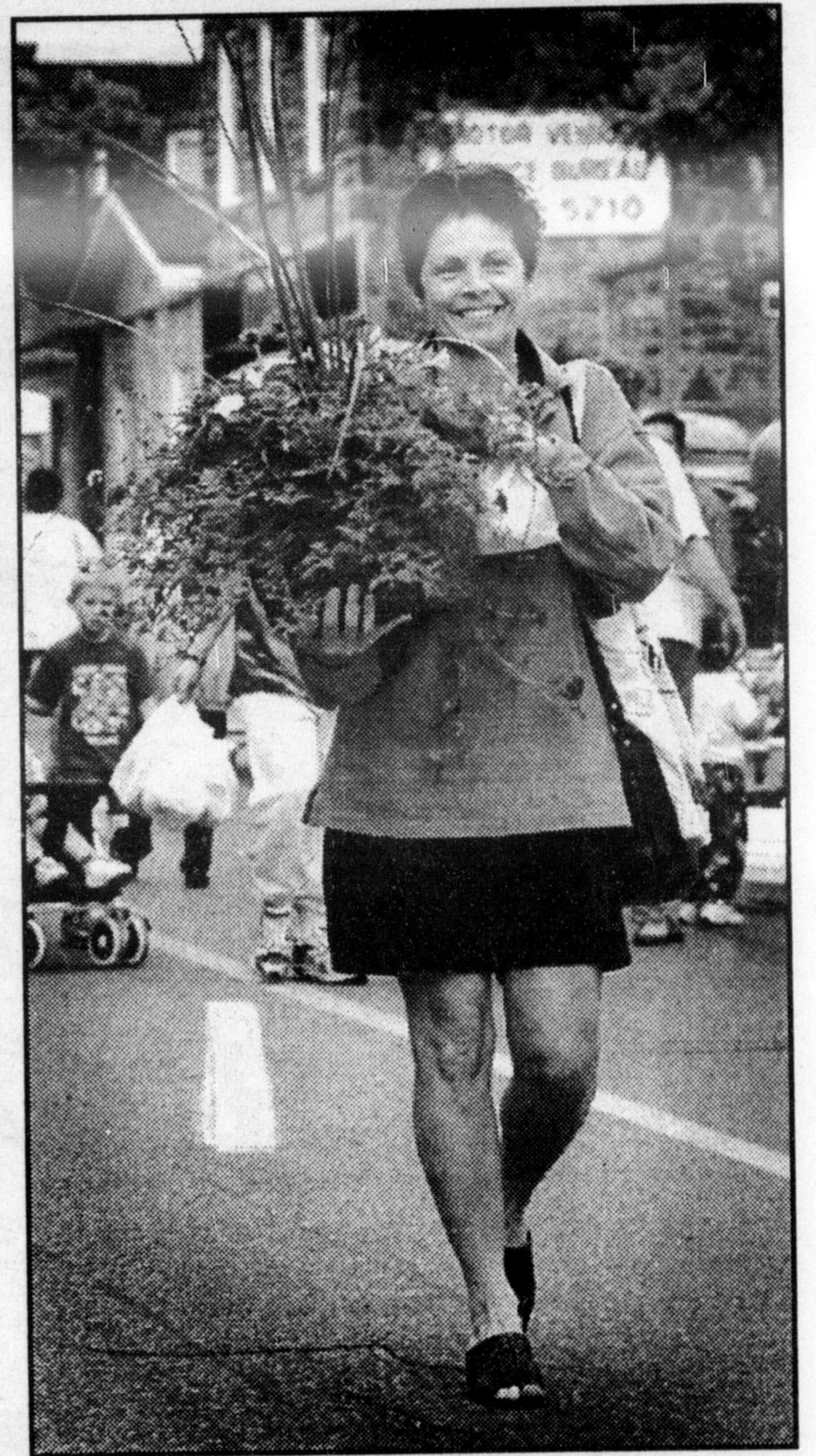

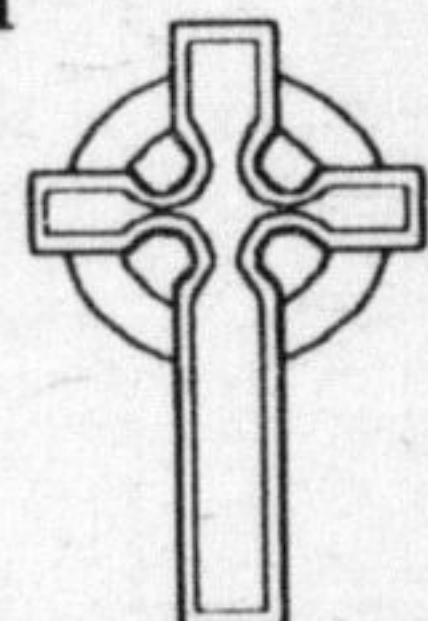

Jocks, preps, punks, Goths and Geeks, these are some of the terms a recent Newsweek article said that young people are calling themselves. This same article went on to say that in the United States by the year 2010 there will be 35 million teenagers, which is a population bigger than the "baby boomers" at their height.

These kids have never known war and they have access, particularly the girls to unprecedented opportunities in post secondary education and careers. However, the other side of the coin reveals many kids even those on the honour role who are increasingly alienated and alone and are unable to connect to their parents and teachers. These kids immerse themselves in T.V. the Internet and movies which

desensitize them to violence and personal moral responsibility.

The Newsweek article points out that half of these kids lived through their parents divorce, 63% live in a household where both parents work outside the home and only 35% say they are understood by their parents.

In a world that is flying by young people are desperately looking for guidance and direction. Being a Father of two children myself one statistic really jumped out at me. While 85% of teens said that Mom cares very much about them, only 58% said that Dad did.

I was blessed to have the kind of Dad that made extra efforts to get to events and activities that my sister, brother, and I were and even today are involved in. He modeled practical, realistic Christianity for me and He remains for

me the greatest earthly man that I know.

But what about you? Maybe you're a young person in a home where everybody seems to be busy for you or maybe Dad or Mom is not in your home. The Bible says that Jesus will be a friend to the friendless and a father to the fatherless and He will set the lonely in families, Psalm 68:5-6

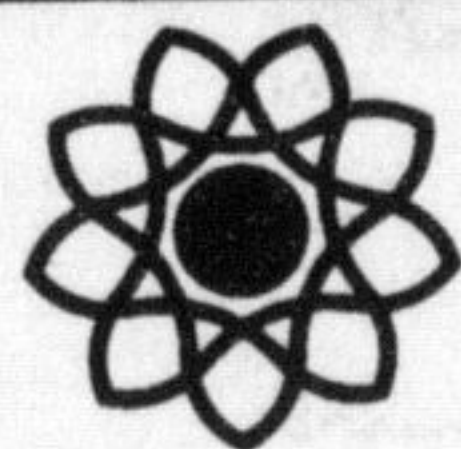
