# Councillors worried about growth expense

Halton council has upheld a committee decision to put a region-wide development charges bylaw on hold.

Under the new Provincial Development Charges Act, all municipalities must have their bylaws in place by August 31.

The idea behind the charges is to ensure that developers, and not the current tax base, pay the freight for growth.

But changes to the Act have some councillors wondering if the Region will be able to make good on its policy to have growth pay for itself.

### TAX NOTICE

Ratepayers of the Town of Milton are reminded that the first installment of the 1999 Final Tax Bill is due on June 30/99

If you require information about taxes, please contact the Corporate Services Tax Department at 878-7252, ext. 393, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, Monday to Friday.

Tax payments must be received in the Corporate Services Office on or before the due date to avoid penalty. Late payment charge of 1 1/4% will be charged on the first day of default and on the first day of each calendar month in which the default continues. It is the responsibility of the ratepayer to ensure that the taxes are paid by the due date, even in the event that the bill is not received as mailed.

#### Taxes may be paid:

- a) By mail to the Corporate Services Tax Department, 43 Brown St., Milton ON L9T 5H2  
Cheques post-dated to the date are acceptable & encouraged.
- b) By phone if you bank with Canada Trust, TD Bank, CIBC, Royal Bank or Bank of Montreal.  
Please call them for details.
- c) By using the mail deposit box to the left of the glass doors at Town Hall.
- d) Between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:30 pm at the Corporate Services Tax Department, Town Hall, 43 Brown St., Milton. (Cheque or money orders preferred rather than cash). Direct Debit now accepted.
