# Thornhill still haunting the Red Sox midget reps

The third time was not the charm for Milton's midget A rep Red Sox.

In fact they could beat Thornhill just once out of three baseball games at the Mississauga North AAA Midget Tournament.

Luck stuck with Thornhill, however, as they went on to win the title while the Red Sox bowed out in the consolation finals. A previously stalwart Milton defence lost its rhythm. Guelph, one of the better major age teams in the western loop, beat the Sox 12-4 in that showdown.

Milton started off strongly, posting a 3-1 record for second place standing in the round robin portion of play. When things got sticky later on as the defence faltered, dropping two games meant that the Sox finished the tournament at 3-3.

Manager Larry Black is quietly confident despite the defensive lapse. "This is a team of eight majors and six minors (in age grouping) playing good quality baseball against mostly major midget teams. We are slowly starting to gel and by the (league) playoffs and OBAs (provincial playdowns) we will be contenders."

Milton faced tough Thornhill in game one and the Red Sox were doubled 6-3. Nathan Perrott was the losing pitcher, going the distance and surrendering eight hits and five walks while striking out two. Mike Austen cracked two singles. Jeff MacLeod launched a double and swatted in a run, Jordan Jeans doubled and Perrott helped out with a single.

Reese Davies and Jeans were solid in the infield while Paul Duff, MacLeod and Austen patrolled the perimeter effectively.

In game two Milton edged host Mississauga North 9-8. Jarred Konkle was the winning pitcher, surrendering nine hits and a walk while setting down three. Perrott was hot at the plate with two doubles and a triple. He batted in two runs. MacLeod hit two doubles and a single, Mark Antonelli dinged a double and

batted in two. Duff hit two singles, Jeans doubled and singled and Mark Black singled and notched one of his two RBI with a sacrifice bunt.

Jeans and Ryan Harper turned two double plays. In game three Milton shut out Orillia 9-0 as Duff threw a one-hitter, allowing just another walk and notching eight Ks.

Ryan Harper hit a double and two singles, Evan Jeans batted a double and a single, Mike Volpe cracked two singles and Davies doubled.

Milton got a little payback in their next contest against Thornhill as they shaded their powerhouse opponents 2-1. It was a pitcher's duel, with MacLeod coming out on top. He threw seven innings (a complete minor league game), recording just two hits and four walks with eight strikeouts during a 121 pitch marathon.

Perrott provided the heroics with a two-run homer. Milton put together an outstanding defensive effort for this one. Of particular note was a Konkle to Perrott double play as Konkle made a deep catch in right field and relayed to Perrott on third for the back end.

Thornhill was not to be victimized twice, however, as they thumped Milton 11-1 in the semifinal rematch. The bottom fell out for Milton in this one, Black indicated.

Kevin Cooper gamely started for Milton, but he hasn't had a lot of pitching time so far this season and the defence wasn't helping much, with errors in bunches after recording only four through the round robin.

In Milton's final game, the defence was again conspicuously absent and Perrott shouldered the loss. He gamely performed at the plate, however, hitting two homers and driving in two baserunners. Jeans doubled and singled while MacLeod singled.

A Guelph outfielder robbed Davies of his first homer with an over-the-fence catch.

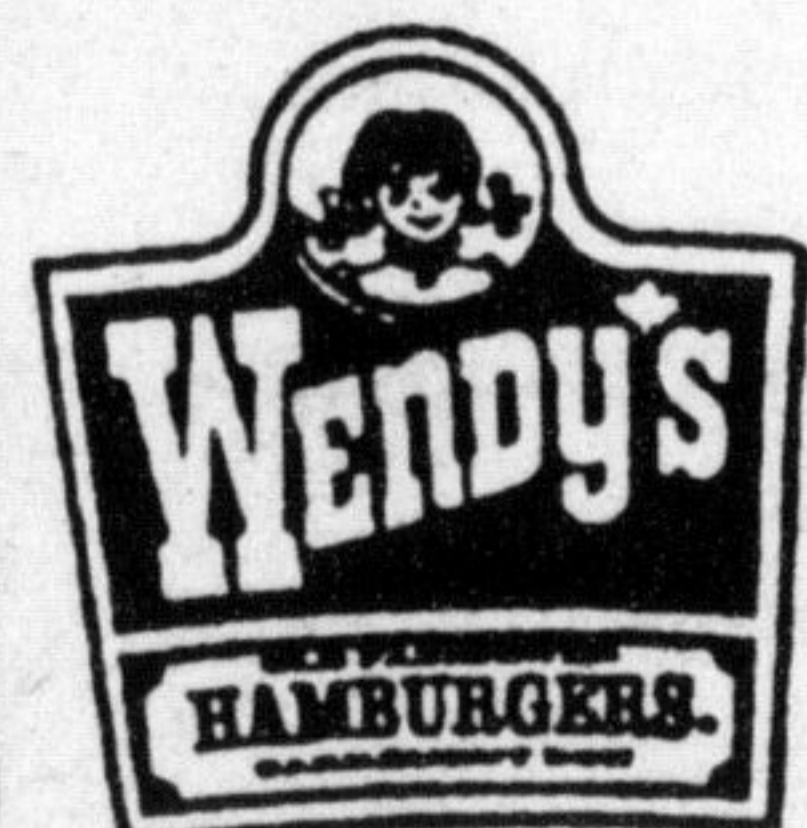
