the definite connection, I'm just trying to open it up."

For Mr. Mann, opening it up — or seeing outside of the box in planning terms — is a natural talent. "I sort of have this ability to see connections that other people don't."

Much of that stems from a dizzying array of interests, which include watercolour painting and photography as well as mathematics, art and moral philosophy.

The religious and Masonic content of *Labyrinth* could make it a hot issue in some circles, said Mr. Mann.

Even academia could be thrown by his encouragement to think outside of traditional history lessons.

"If you start challenging that formal history, you start challenging their tenancy," he said. "You start getting an upheaval of the university system."

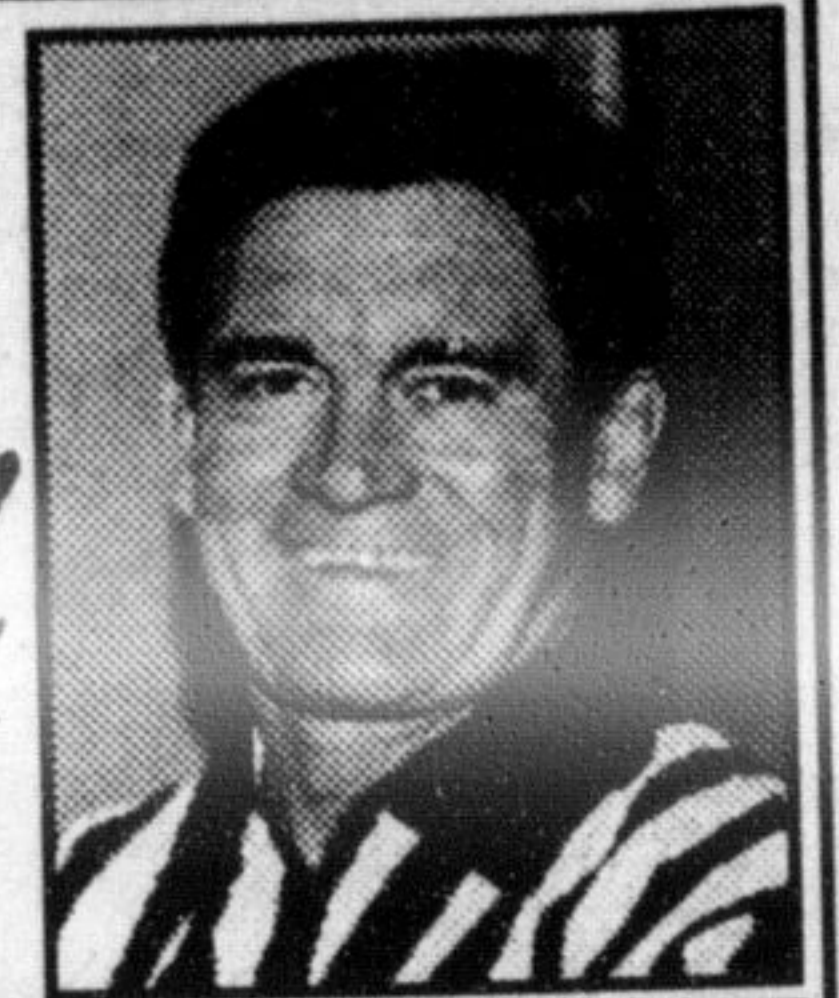
The book's content seemed too contentious for Canadian publishers, said Mr. Mann, who eventually went to the Alabama company, Laughing Owl Publishing Inc.
