## Peewees show they belong among best

There's an agony and ecstasy that go along with any major sporting comeback.

Milton's major peewee baseball team experienced both in the span of a few hours Monday — during the late stages of the prestigious AAA Ontario Eliminations in Orillia.

The Red Sox' emotional roller coaster began on a high note. With just five of 16 served them so well this season — proved teams still alive in the double knockout to be their undoing as a double play event — to determine a single representative for the nationals — the local boys engineered a remarkable rally to upstage the Mississauga Majors 9-7 and guarantee themselves a top three finish.

They amassed six runs in the seventh inning to tie it, before scoring twice more during the extra frame.

"Usually the coaches have to pump up the players, but they were doing it themselves," said manager Dan Tielemans, who described the morning game as the team's biggest comeback this year. "They just wouldn't quit."

David Aggio provided the heroics, driving in the go-ahead run and holding opposing batters both hitless and scoreless through the final five innings with superb pitching.

He delivered 10 strikeouts along the way.

Also standing tall with four hits and a couple of runs was Troy Ethier - who initiated the big rally and brought home the insurance run.

Milton would end up on the other end of the comeback game in their next outing against Birchmont. Up 6-0 after three

innings — with their eyes set towards the finals and even a title triumph — the peewees' sizable lead slipped away and they wound up losing 8-6.

They had a couple of players aboard in their last at-bat and had a chance to take another one to extra innings. However, aggressive base running — which has crushed their hopes for victory.

Burlington White went on to trim Birchmont 3-2 and earn the trip out east to the Canadian Championship. Able to take along 18 players — three more than are currently on their roster — they've invited multi-talented Aggio to join them for the national tournament.

"For Milton to place top three at a triple A tournament like this is unbelievable," explained Tielemans.

The Red Sox won three other games at the holiday weekend showcase — the most exciting of which was a 3-1 decision over Cambridge.

Outfielder Justin Deshaw made a sensational catch to save two runs while he and David Tielemans registered the RBI. Aggio and Hallan King split the mound work and combined for a four-hitter.




The event will serve as a qualifier for the provincial finals, Labour Day weekend.






