Untimely errors do in Milton's title bid

So close, so agonizingly close. That was the story for the local major peewee baseball team at the Central Ontario Baseball Association finals — held last weekend in Brampton.

Multiple miscues in the field eventually caught up with the normally defensively solid Red Sox, who were nipped 17-15 by Mississauga North Sunday in the championship game.

Milton enjoyed sound pitching throughout the tournament as well as some timely hitting, but a rash of errors — many of which came at the worst possible moments — cost them a gold medal plus a berth to the provincials.

"The fielding just wasn't there," said manager Dan Tielemans.

The Red Sox staked themselves to an early lead in the finals before their last defensive collapse — in which they gave up 11 runs in just two innings.

After there, the locals had to play catch up in order to keep it close.

Added Milton's skipper, "At one point, we made five straight errors. When you do that and give up

17 runs, you're not going to win too many games."

David Aggio, Liam Tennant and David Tielemans all delivered multi-hit efforts in the finals — and scored three runs each.

Mississauga North had played two fewer games leading up to the title match — which no doubt gave them a slight edge.

Errors nearly spelled disaster in the semifinals as well.

Milton placed a 7-1 stranglehold on Burlington Blue before coming apart and barely holding on for a 9-7 win.

Aggio, Tennant, Tielemans and Hallan King combined for an effective pitching campaign while leading at the plate with three hits and three RBI was Justin Deshaw. Troy Ethier had a stand-out offensive game as well — with two hits and a pair of runs scored.

The Red Sox collected three other victories at the double knockout tournament — the most impressive of which was a 12-5 decision over the Mississauga Majors, who had beaten them 4-1 in round two before falling victim to the revenge

game. Milton's payback win was highlighted by a three-run homer by Ethier and three strong innings on the hill by Aggio.

The team's second place showing in the league finals is the latest in a series of impressive efforts, including tournament wins in Hamilton and Mississauga plus a bronze medal at the Ontario Eliminations.

Rounding out this year's highly successful squad are Tim Colling, Marcus Gray, Jon Jeysman, Matt Mastrangelo, Nick Mazzorato and John Scholtz.
