

Night at the races and casino will be millennium fundraiser

The Milton 2000 committee is adding up its pennies in order to count down the new millennium.

To ensure the numbers tally up, the committee is throwing a Community Night fundraiser at Mohawk Raceway.

Tickets to the Thursday, Oct. 14 event sell for \$40 a pop.

That buys a lavish buffet dinner and an electrifying evening at the races.

It also provides an opportunity to scope out the new, glamourized raceway complete with 750 slot machines.

The dining room opens at 6:30 p.m. and races kick off an hour

later.

Groups, companies and organizations are invited to join in the fun and promote themselves at the same time by sponsoring a race.

That will earn them a trip to the winner's circle for an up close and personal view of the proceedings.

More events coming

Future fundraisers are also in the works.

They include a Brazilian ball, Las Vegas night and a possible excursion to see the Lion King at the Princess of Wales theatre.

Proceeds will go towards sprucing up the Town through public

projects such as the Mill Pond, Town trails and a millennium garden.

The committee is also working on making the millennium memorable through January 1 celebrations, a time capsule and a community calendar highlighting all the festive events dotted through 2000.

NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF AN EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT CHARGES BY-LAW BY THE HALTON DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD

TAKE NOTICE that the Halton District School Board passed an Education Development Charges By-Law on the 18th day of August, 1999, under section 257.54 of the *Education Act, 1997*.

AND TAKE NOTICE that any person or organization may appeal the By-Law to the Ontario Municipal Board under section 257.65 of the Act by filing with the Secretary of the Halton District School Board on or before the 27th day of September, 1999, a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the By-Law and the reasons supporting the objection.

The By-Law comes into force on August 31, 1999. The education development charges imposed by the By-law are as follows:

- \$874.00 per dwelling unit in regard to residential development
- \$0.19 per square foot of gross floor area in regard to non-residential development

The education development charges are imposed on all development of lands in the Region of Halton. Accordingly, a key map showing the location of the lands subject to the By-Law is not provided as part of this notice.

A copy of the complete By-law is available for examination in the offices of the Board located at 2050 Guelph Line, Burlington, Ontario, during regular office hours.

Notice of a proposed by-law amending the education development charge by-law or the passage of such an amending by-law is not required to be given to any person or organization, other than to certain clerks of municipalities or secretaries of school boards, unless the person or organization gives the secretary of the Board a written request for notice or any amendments to the education development charge by-law and has provided a return address.
