# Cheerleader will perform in front of 80,000 raucous Buffalo Bills fans

Set aside the sequins and forget about the stereotypes — cheerleading isn't for sissies anymore.

So says Ronda Copeland, the sole Canadian member of the 1999-2000 NFL Buffalo Bills cheerleading team.

Grueling four-hour rehearsals that can make a heart pump like a piston and featherweight pompoms feel like lead are just the start.

These girls are supposed to smile through it all, too.

In Ms Copeland's case, that may appear more like a 1,000-watt beam.

And why not? At 28, Ms Copeland spent much of the month of June beating a path to Buffalo in order to triumph over the more than 100 American gals who competed for a place on the 35-member team.

### Was Argo cheerleader

"Everybody was very intense," recalled Ms Copeland, who also runs a Main Street dance studio. "It was very obvious they really wanted to be on the team."

Of course she, also, really wanted to be on the team.

And she had the background, having served as a Toronto Argonaut cheerleader from 1996-98.

She also took up dance when she was four, and learned social graces fit for a queen upon being crowned the 1998 Miss Toronto.

But what she lacked was a yen for cheerleading fed to her like mother's milk.



In other words, they are very serious about cheerleading in the United States, where training usually begins in the junior schools. Currently the push is on to have it categorized as a sport.

But for all that, cheerleading sometimes suffers from a reputation of being mostly about looking pretty for the fans.

### An eye opener

"The stereotype is someone who is just there to dance and perform and doesn't have much else going for them," said Ms Copeland.

"But it is an eye opener when you meet the girls who are performing. I'm honoured to be on the team."

What counts on the field is ability, not appearance, said Ms Copeland.
