keep him interested," said Pierce, who also guided the colt to victory in the Cane Pace, the first leg of the Triple Crown on September 4 at Freehold Raceway. "It sure feels good to drive a colt like this. He's the horse to beat in the Jug. The Panderosa better be ready."

Wallace, who has had confidence in Blissfull Hall's abilities all along, said he is continuing to

improve.

"He continues to amaze," said the local trainer. "The way he crossed the wire tonight after being roughed up a little bit — a half in :54.2 — I was concerned. He coasted to the wire. We've got a serious player here. I didn't realize it, but he's now got a track record on a mile track, a track record on a half-mile and a track record on a seven-eighths mile."

In the second Simcoe division, another Jug eligible re-established himself as a major contender. Island Fantasy spotted the early leaders plenty of ground, and then came flying off cover to win by three expanding lengths for Mike Lachance in 1:52.

"He hasn't been consistent his last four or five starts so I didn't know what to expect tonight," said Lachance.

## Looks sharp

Pat Lynch's surroundings may have changed, but his efforts on the mound remain constant.

The 21-year-old pitcher — traded late last month to the Colorado Rockies and sent to their class-A farm team in Asheville, North Carolina — got in two solid outings before his new club wrapped up the season.

His Asheville Tourists debut featured a handful of strikeouts and just two hits in seven scoreless innings, en route to the team's 9-1 trouncing of the Macon Braves.

"I had great location on my fastball and my change-up was also working well," remarked the right-handed hurler, during a brief hiatus in town last weekend.

Start number two wasn't quite as memorable, although certainly credible. Lynch surrendered six hits — three of which were infield hops that should have been turned into outs — through five innings and lost to Capital City, South Carolina 5-2.

"The numbers might indicate otherwise, but it was a good game. I was happy with both outings," he said Asheville finished 35-35 and failed to make the playoffs.
