The Milton District Mustangs' junior football team corralled four touchdowns — three on offence and another by way of an interception — en route to a 27-6 romp over Burlington's Lester B. Pearson Patriots Wednesday.

MD delivered a particularly potent ground game in their home opening victory, which came in the middle of a steady afternoon downpour that hampered both schools' air strike.

"We gave the ball to a few different players and got a nice balance

of production," said veteran coach Vern O'Neil.

Greg Van Es rushed for two majors while also reaching the end zone were Tom Daniel and Josh Suter, who picked off a pass and ran it back for the first defensive touchdown of the season.

The 'Stangs went 3-for-4 on convert attempts. Justin Preece made good on two of these while booting the other was Chance Stewart.

Adam Dow blocked two kicks by the visitors to further crush their week-one efforts. Other standout

performances on defense came from Scott Carey and Pat Durman.

With all eight teams in the second division making the playoffs this fall, the local squad's aim now is to build on this early success and secure home-field advantage for round one.

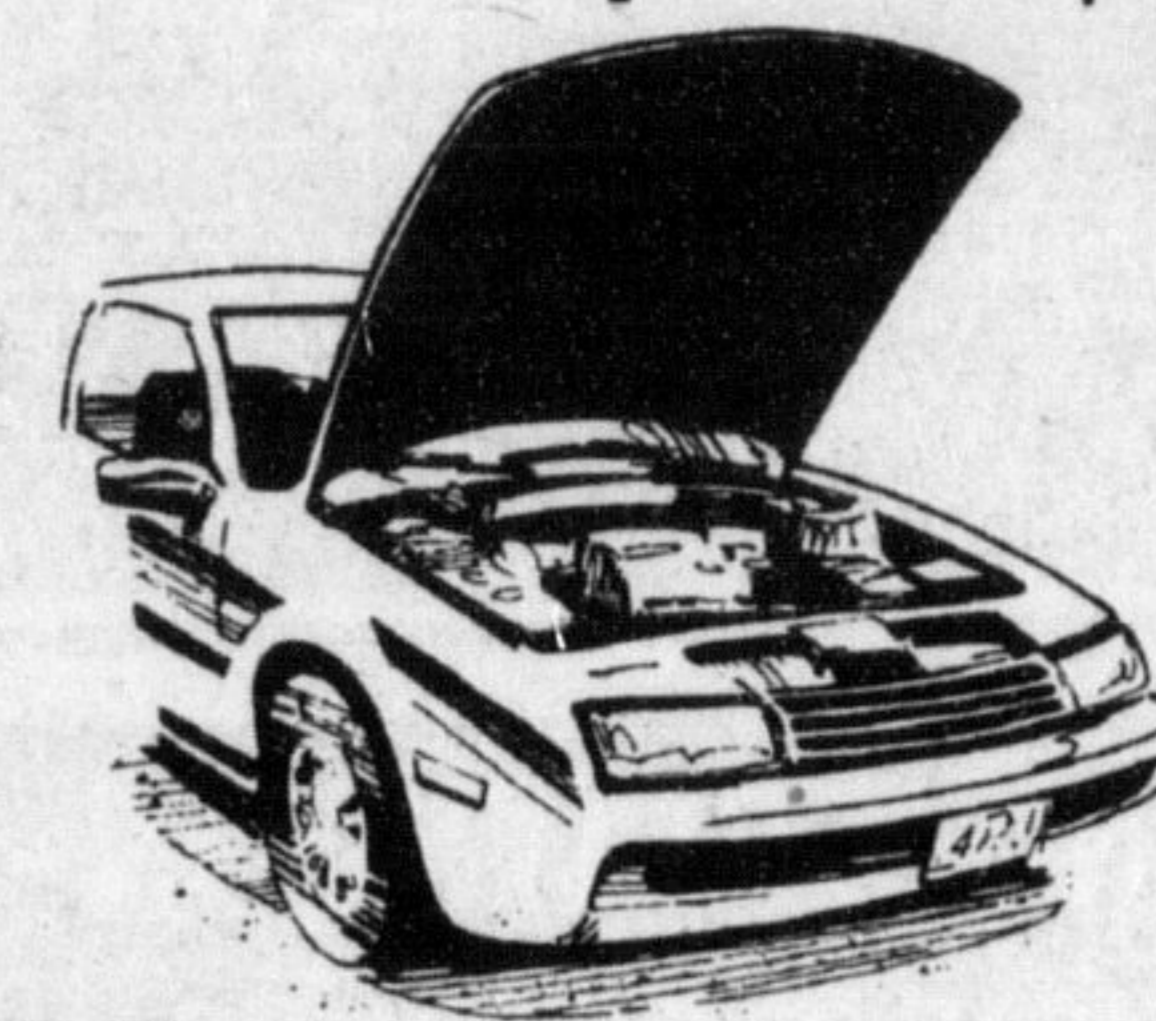
