July, after one anesthetist fell ill and another resigned.

And the two remaining doctors can't possibly keep up with the demand, said Dr. King.

"We have two guys and that's why we don't have 24-hour coverage," said Dr. King. "You're asking someone to be on call 24hours-a-day, seven days a week."

Since the shortage began, two surgeries have had to be rerouted to Oakville due to a lack of manpower at the Milton site, said Dr. King.

Ironically, MDH lost one anesthetist in the spring because he felt there wasn't enough work to go around at the time.

"He wasn't busy since we had lost obstetrics," said Dr. King. "There was a real slowdown in the are in short supply all across the • see a related story on page 10

But demand has increased dramatically since that unit re-opened October 4. And added services at the hospital including plastic and orthopedic surgery have dramatically inflated the need for anes-
