## Studio Tour making encore

After years of toiling in isolation, local artists are developing a taste for teamwork.

The result is the upcoming Milton area's second annual Studio

Tour.

The event, which is run by the Fine Arts Society of Milton (FASM), takes place Saturday, Oct. 23 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Sunday, Oct. 24 from noon until 5 p.m. at a variety of artist studios from Milton to Moffatt and beyond.

"We'd try to keep it in this area,"

said FASM president Marion Detlor. "That was important, so people could drive without going too far."

This year, the tour will feature 19 artists and artisans at 14 locations. That is up from 14 artists in 12 locations at last year's event.

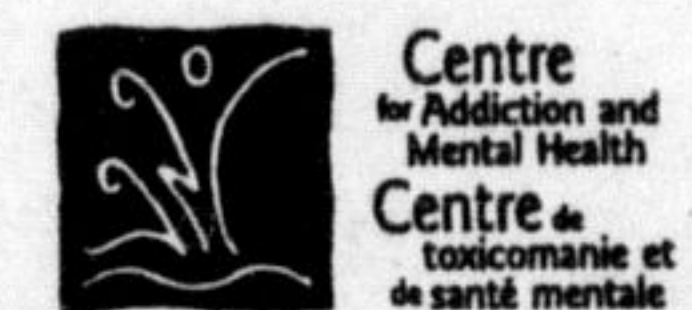

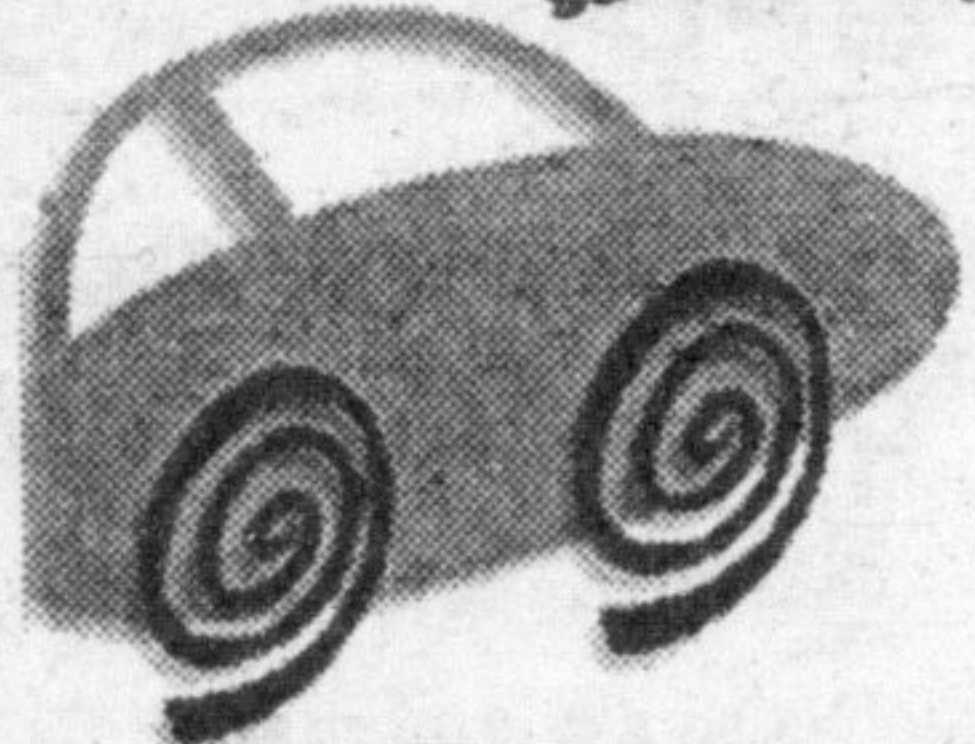

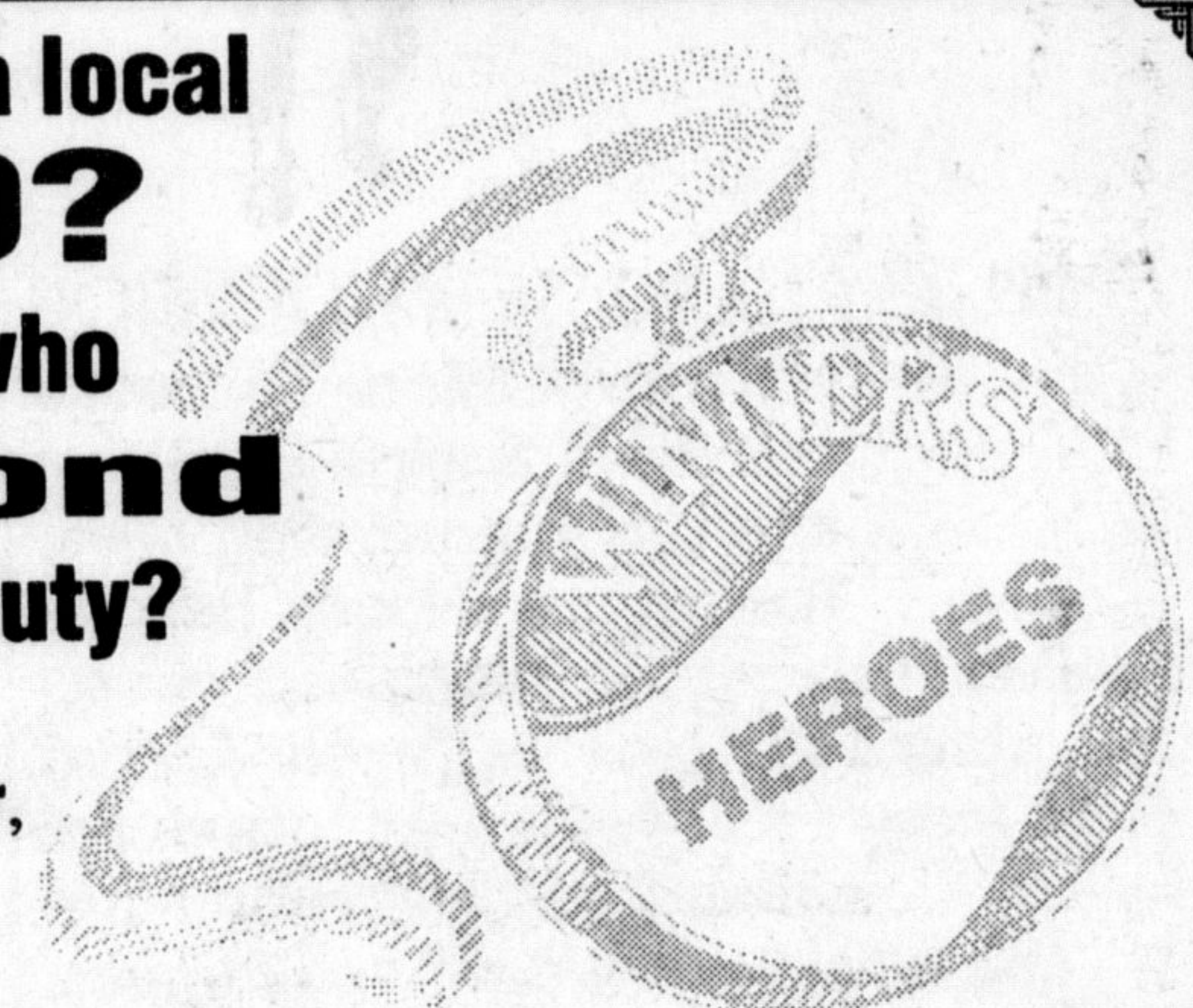
