## Fans of Stratton pack church for classics concert

Thunderous applause from a packed house launched the first in a series of concerts at the Milton Alliance Church recently.

The debut show from Milton Concert Presentations put the spotlight on the talents of Maestro Kerry Stratton and the 46-strong Toronto Philharmonia.

The evening's theme was 'Ride to the Rescue', and included classic horse and rider sounds like Gioacchino Rossini's William Tell Overture, Haydn's La Fedelta Premiata (Fidelity's Reward), and Cesar Franck's Le Chassuer Maudit (The Accursed Huntsman).

All pieces were explained in advance by Mr. Stratton, allowing music lovers to catch nuances that may otherwise have gone unnoticed.

But he willingly stepped out of the limelight for a moment when Milton's Christine West took over the baton to direct usher the orchestra through the tricky bits of the William Tell Overture.

The opportunity to step up to the stage had been won in a silent auction earlier in the year. The evening wrapped up with a standing ovation for Mr. Stratton and the Philharmonia.

### More concerts ahead

More concerts are lined up for the season, including the 'Great Lakes Guitar Duo' November 19 and 'Mozart in Prague' featuring Mr. Stratton, the Toronto Philharmonia and pianist Boris Krajny January 21.

'Brass by Request', a concert starring the Toronto Philharmonia's brass quintet, will also feature a silent auction on March 24, while violinist Jasper Wood will join the Toronto Philharmonia and Kerry Stratton for a final concert May 5:
