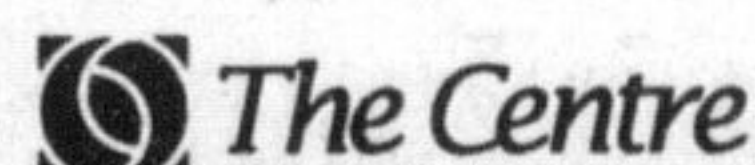

A sneak preview of displays aimed at an upcoming open house will be featured for staff, physicians and volunteers.

The displays will reflect the work of individual departments both in the past and the present.

Stocking up on Christmas gifts this season will be easy thanks to the Milton District Hospital Auxiliary's Christmas Craft Sale and Luncheon at 11:30 a.m. next Friday. Baking and knitting tables as well as unique crafts will be on

display at the sale.
