school's fundraising team. Sending Milton representatives overseas can even be a community project, thanks to the cash-raising efforts of businesses such as the Hops 'N' Malt and Waltzing Weasel, said Ms DeBattista.

And \$3,000 was recently raised thanks to a raffle for four Riverdance tickets, donated by an anonymous well-wisher.

Victoria confessed to doing a double-take when it was her name the judges announced for the top spot at the Eastern contest.

But confidence could be Cian's middle name. Despite strapping on his first pair of dancing shoes less than two short years ago, the Milton boy placed first in the age nine and under category at the Easterns. Now he is ready to take other competitions by storm.

"I think I have a good chance and I think I am going to win," he said.

And to do that, he really needs to remember one thing. "Feet turned out."

### ADVERTORIAL BEER CANS

Hogshead Brew offers a beer canning machine. What this allows is a customer to can their beer instead of putting it in plastic bottles. For those customers still wishing to use their own bottles this option is still available. Being able to can your beer means no more bottles to bring in and sanitize each time, you just recycle the cans in your blue box. Canning takes 20-30 min. per batch; a batch is just over 6 cases of 355 ml cans (52L.) and costs approx. \$17.00 per case. There are small batches also available; these are 2 3/4 cases of cans (23L.). The cans also allow the beer to stay fresher longer than the plastic bottles previously allowed. The cans can be put into 6-pack rings for easy carrying and storing or they can be left individual in cases. A customer can also use the canning machine for their coolers. Hogshead has over 170 beer recipes to choose from; they range from lite beers to stout style beers. Whether cans or bottles, beer, wine or coolers let Hogshead look after your beverage making needs.
