

Driver flees car crash at Britannia and First Line

Investigation continues in a hit-and-run accident at Britannia Road and First Line last Friday.

Police report that a vehicle travelling westbound on Britannia Road went through the stop sign and struck another vehicle that was northbound on First Line.

The suspect stopped briefly, but then left the scene without offering any assistance. The make of the vehicle is unknown.

Traffic light downed

Police are searching for the driver of a gray-coloured car that knocked down a traffic light at Derry and Trafalgar roads Tuesday.

Debris from the vehicle, which immediately fled the area, was left at the scene of the accident, which caused roughly \$5,000 damage to the light.

Lumber lifted

Lumber valued at \$2,700 was removed from a unfinished garage being built by

Millstone Construction on Steeles Avenue. The theft occurred sometime between 6 p.m. November 29 and 7 a.m. December 1.

Free fill-up

A garbage-type dump truck was filled with \$309 worth of diesel fuel that wasn't paid for during a fill-up at the Pioneer gas station on Trafalgar Road December 2.

The incident occurred at about 10 p.m. and investigation into the matter is continuing.

Car stereo stolen

A JVC compact disc player and a wallet containing a small amount of cash was removed from a 1996 Pontiac Sunfire sometime between November 26 and December 3.

The vehicle was parked at business on Lawson Road at the time. The driver's side door lock was pried over.

The total value of the loss was about \$400.
