

Highway help available in police sign program

New, more visible 'Call Police' signs now available in police's popular Highway Help Program

There's a safe and effective way for people to get help on Canada's highways — the highway help sign.

The Highway Help Program helps motorists give and receive assistance.

To date, more than 350,000 people have highway help signs in their vehicle.

People who require assistance simply have to hang the 'Call Police' sign

in their window. The sign protrudes into traffic, and is visible to motorists from both directions.

Police just issued a new sign coated with 3M's reflective sheeting. The sheeting makes it easier to see at night or in poor weather.

People who see the sign can call police from their cellular phone. (On Ontario highways, the number is

*OPP.) Police will respond to ensure the person is okay.

The upgraded Highway Help Program allows people to offer their assistance without leaving the security of their vehicle, and without putting either the stranded motorist or the good Samaritan at risk.

"The Halton Regional Police Service is pleased to be involved in

this worthwhile program," said Chief Ean Algar.

"It further enhances the safety of the motoring public."

We've added years to life, but not life to our years.*

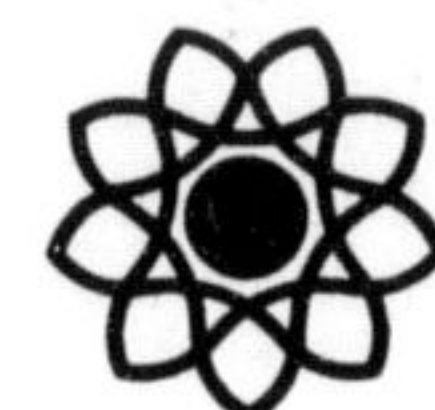
*We've conquered outer space, but not inner space;

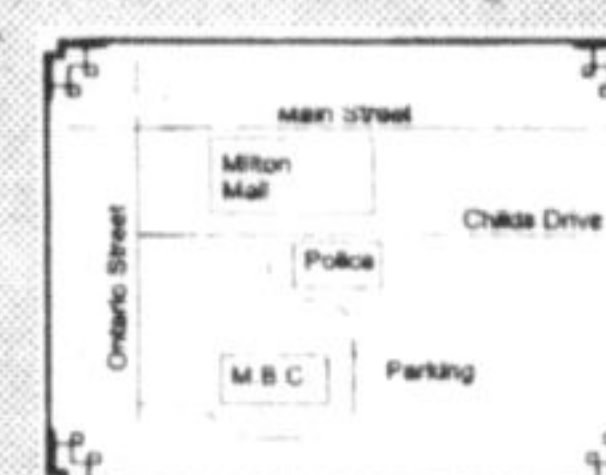
