✓ Arena damaged

Two 14-year-old Milton youths have been charged with committing a break-in that caused approximately \$15,000 in damage to John Tonelli Sports Centre.

The break-in occurred between midnight and 5:20 a.m. Wednesday.

The suspects allegedly smashed the front doors to gain access into the arena and ransacked the concession area, lobby and office before damaging pop and vending machines. They also allegedly put the beverage Slush Puppy on the ice.

"The culprits demolished the place," said Derrick Neelands, supervisor of arenas for the Town of Milton. "It's the worse anyone had ever seen of all the break and enters."

When the caretaker arrived, two suspects fled through the north doors, returning to pick up personal property that one left behind.

When they came back out, Halton Regional Police were there to arrest them, said Det. Sgt. Jackie Gordon.
