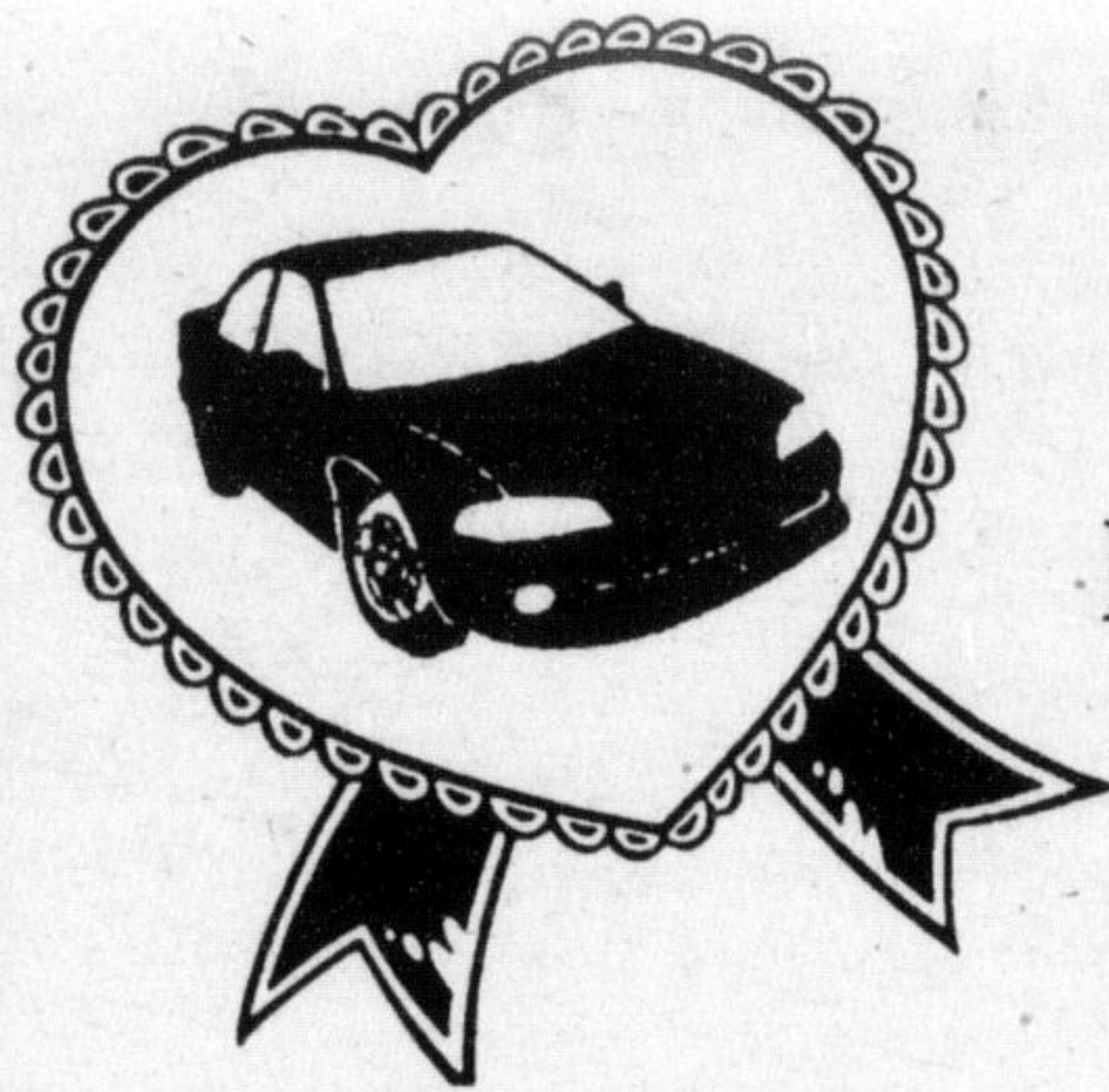

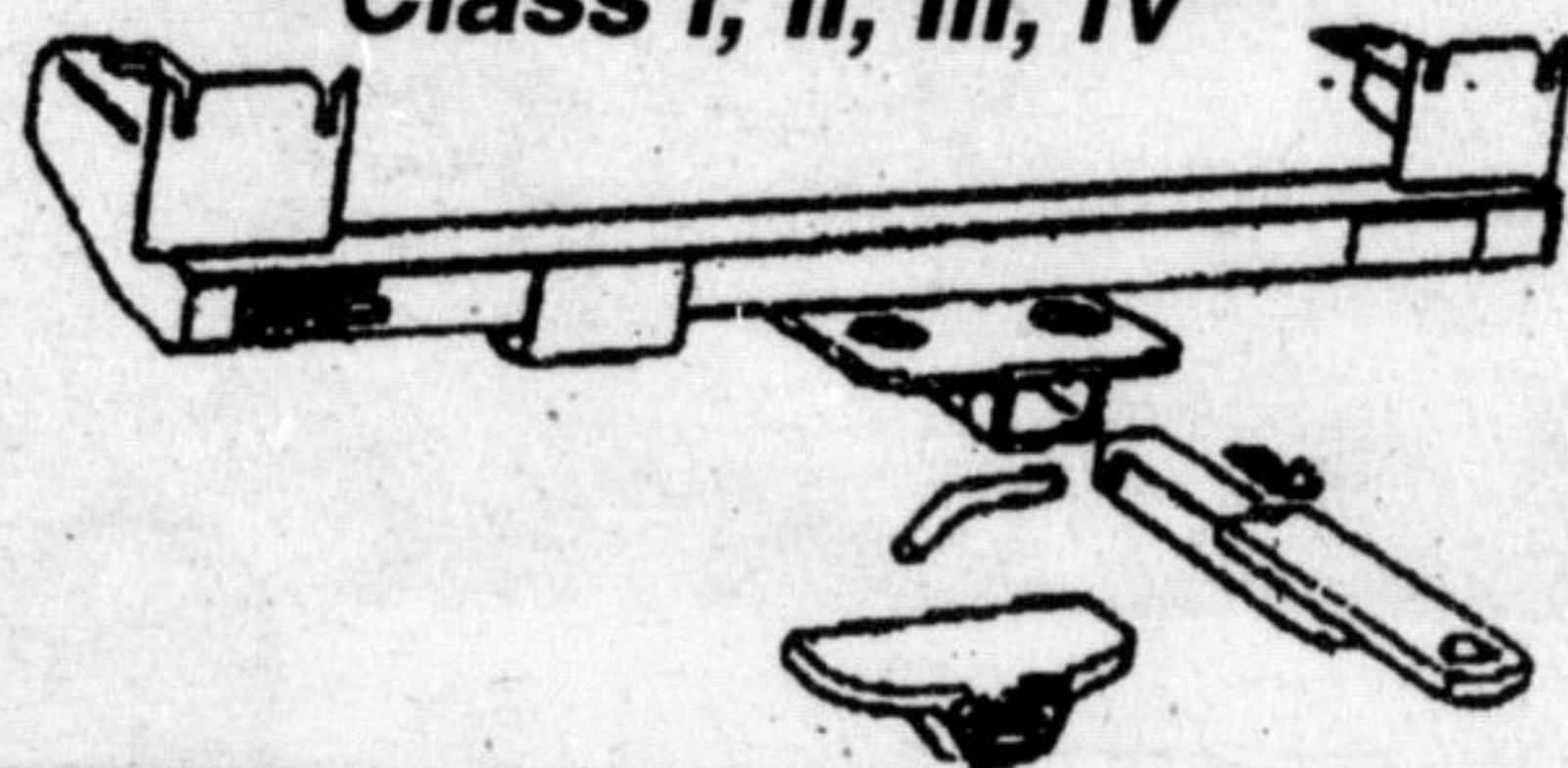

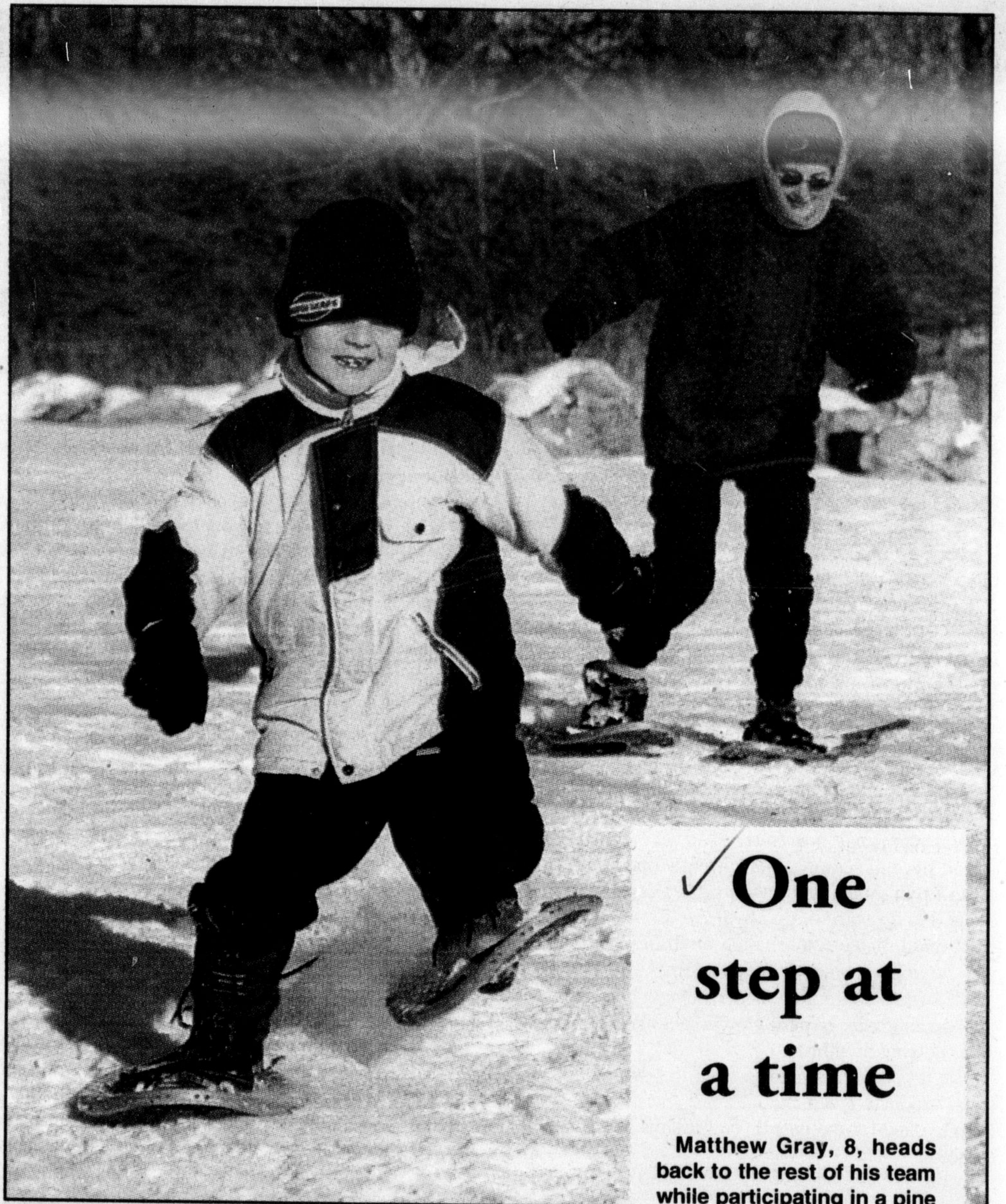

BUSINESS ANALYST
