Melanson earns top grade for attendance

Penman, Lunau and Challinor each missed only three meetings

When it comes to attendance, Councillor Art Melanson is a high achiever.

According to the Town's 1999 attendance sheet, Mr. Melanson was present for every meeting held that year.

And councillors Brian Penman, Cindy Lunau and John Challinor also proved they were no slackers. They each racked up 44 out of a possible 47 meetings.

Mayor Gord Krantz managed to make 42 of the 47 meetings. He was trailed closely by Councillor Ron Furik, who showed up for 41 meetings.

They were followed by Councillors Rick Malboeuf at 39, Barry Lee at 38, Wally Hunter at 37 and Rick Day at 32.

But Mr. Day fared worse in his role as a council representative on the Heritage Milton (LACAG) committee. Of the 11 meetings held, he showed up once.

Coming in last in the council chambers seat warming race is Councillor Lieven Gevaert. He attended 20 of the 47 1999 meetings.

For their work, councillors are offered a base salary of \$11,684. But that can be deflated through taking voluntary pay cuts. It can also be boosted through the payment of expenses for out of town conferences and workshops.

Overall, \$16,445 was the highest haul, earned by Ms Lunau, who attends many conferences on behalf of the Town.

The lowest take was nothing at all — Mr. Gevaert opted to refuse his salary for the full year.

Conferences helped hike Mr. Penman's take-home pay to \$13,206, while mileage expenses allowed Mr. Lee to pocket \$12,434.

Mr. Melanson, Mr. Day and Mr. Furik all took home the base salary only. Taking pay cuts were Mr. Challinor, \$7,932, Mr. Hunter, \$8,179 and Mr. Malboeuf, \$10, 516.

Mr. Krantz, the only full-time member of council, earned \$41,094 for the year.

Currently, the Town council schedule works on a three week cycle of two committee meetings, followed by a meeting of full council.

All councillors have a vote at council, as


