

Catholic school board forced to revise its budget

Board expecting a budget shortfall for the 2000-01 school year

The Halton District Catholic School Board could be in for a budget shortfall for the 2000-01 school year.

A staff review of the preliminary estimates for the year starting September 2000 indicated that the potential exists for a substantial revenue shortfall unless the board's grant allocation from the Student-Based Funding Model increases

substantially.

According to the board however, it has yet to receive the Ministry of Education's grant regulations for 2000-01, which were expected earlier this month.

This forced the board to delay the release of its 2000-01 draft budget.

The document was supposed to be released last week, but its introduction has been delayed

until March 21.

Board staff felt that in order to prepare a more complete preliminary budget, the original schedule needed to be modified slightly.

The way it appears now, however, is that this isn't expected to alter the final budget completion date of June 6.

The date to receive public feedback on the draft budget has been delayed from April 7 to

April 14 while the second draft of the budget estimate will be presented to the administrative council on May 1 rather than April 17.

The second draft will be presented to the board on May 16 rather than May 2.

Review and approval of the 2000-01 budget estimate by the board then goes ahead as planned June 6.

A child learns self-esteem.*

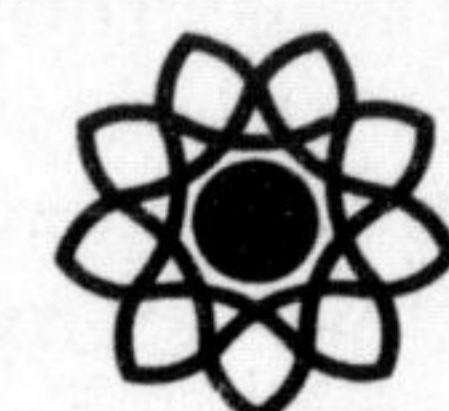
*If a child lives with acceptance and friendship,

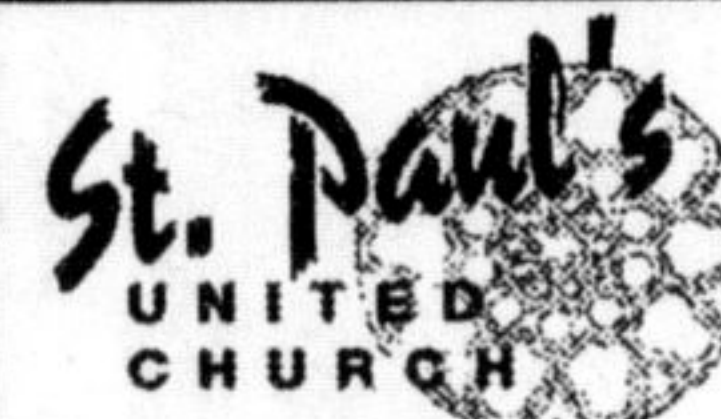

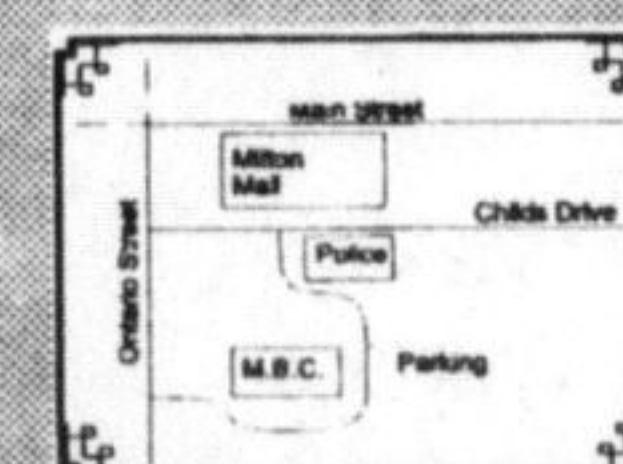
