Volunteers are required to dedicate two to three hours quarterly to aid in advising the clinic on program development, implementation and evaluation.

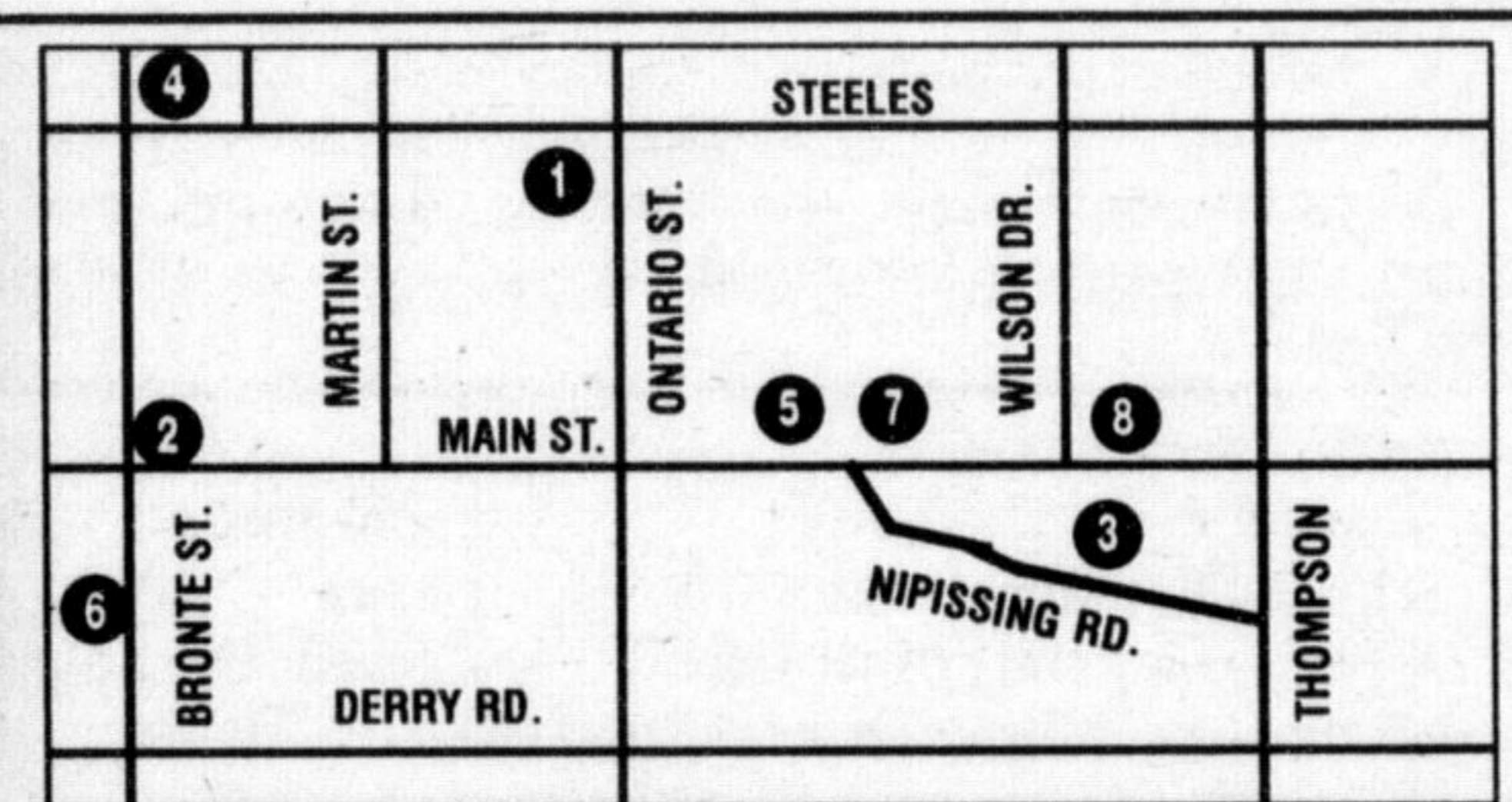
