dip into the capital budget.

But councillors weren't willing to wait any longer.

"This is now a pond with no water," said Councillor Wally Hunter.

"I'm not prepared to put the job off."

They also asked for assurances that enough sediment would be removed to ensure the invasive milfoil — which chokes out native pond species — doesn't return.

And they objected to what they perceived as ill-treatment at the hands of the Town.

"I'm not an engineer, but I'm not stupid of the tender, he added.

"It's a slap in the face to the committee that staff didn't come to us on this and say 'this is the bid we've accepted.""

"It would have been nice if staff had come to committee and allayed these concerns," he said. "Then I don't think there would be a problem."

Through the tender, the Mill Pond restoration should be completed by December at a cost of \$595,000 to \$742,000, down between \$4,000 and \$144,000 from previously-estimated costs.

ARE YOU AFRAID OF THE DARK?

Several years ago, a well-known Television Circus Show developed a Bengal Tiger act. Like the rest of the show, it was done live before a large studio audience. 




