

## Former financial advisor in court

Former Milton financial advisor Michael Bourgon, who faces numerous fraud-related charges, made a brief court appearance Monday.

Mr. Bourgon, who appeared in

Milton court without his lawyer, requested that the judge remand his case to May 8.

Court heard his lawyer, who is involved with another fraud case, is unavailable until then.

The judge granted his request. Mr. Bourgon is charged with 12 counts of fraud over \$5,000, theft over \$5,000 and uttering a forged document after the disappearance of more than \$750,000.

# Driver assaulted in road rage incident

An incident of road rage was recently reported in Milton.

The incident occurred at Woodward Avenue and Wilson Drive at 11:25 a.m. Saturday, Halton Regional Police said.

Police said the ordeal began when the victim made motions at the suspect who went through a light.

The suspect forced the victim over to the curb. While a passenger in the vehicle pinned the victim's door closed, the suspect grabbed the victim around the throat and punched him in the face.

The suspects got back in the car and drove away.

Police are investigating.

You need not give your name and your information can be taken with complete anonymity.

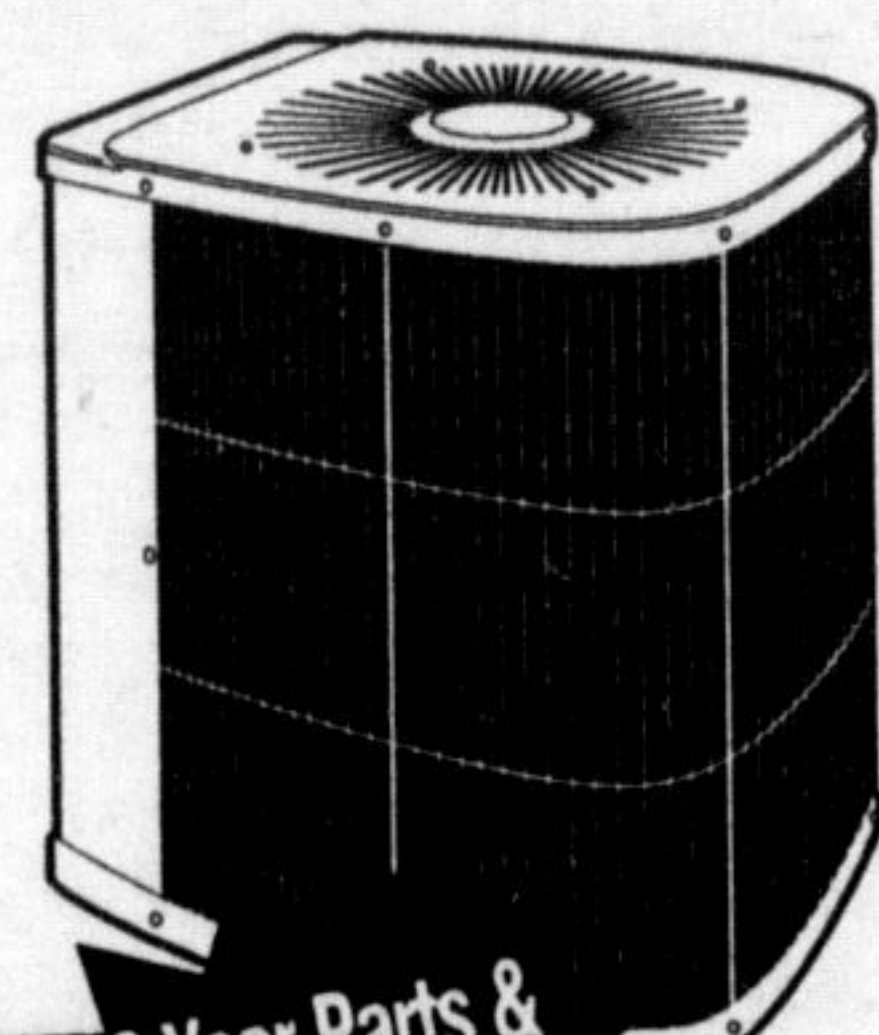

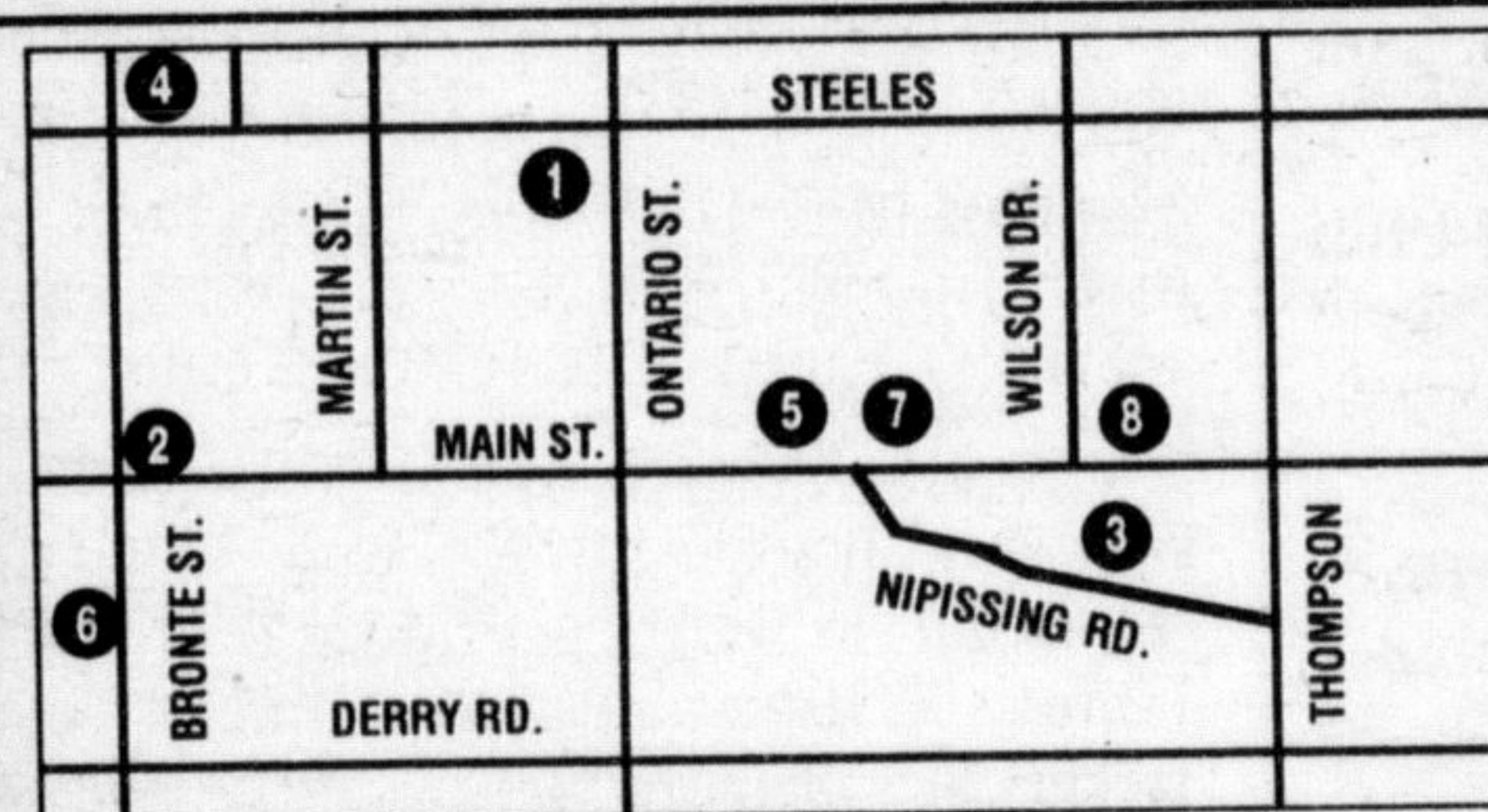
