Krane Corporation and Canadian Tire Corporation, Limited have announced the voluntary public recall of SUPERCYCLE bicycle model 1800S.

It has been discovered that a handlebar stem assembly problem may cause the front fork assembly to fail. This could potentially result in steering difficulties or cause the handlebars to come out, creating a safety concern.

Supercycle 1800S 18-speed MTB can be identified by:

- Grey/silver frame
- Red fork
- Trademark 1800S which appears on the top tube of the frame
- Two wheel sizes—Youths' 24" or Adults' 26" diameter

**This voluntary recall affects only the specified model of bicycle sold at Canadian Tire stores between January and March, 2000.** Products purchased before or after this period meet all Canadian requirements and are not affected by this recall.
