





The committee started selling the stones, he said, as a way to pay for improvements to the church.


But the popularity and beauty of the stones could make it an ongoing way to raise money.

St. Paul's will host a dedication ceremony May 7. Donors and volunteers will be recognized for their contributions to the project, he said.




